By Burke McNeill . Crabgrass can be a troublesome weed in August if it is not attacked in the spring. Because crabgrass is an annual weed, germinating in the early spring, it is often not recognized until brown patches show up in the late summer. Crabgrass can be come offed by pre-emergence herbieides but can be controlled much more satisfactorily by good cultural practices. A well-fertilized lawn mowed at 112-2 inches, will keep crabgrass under con-

Crabgrass does not like shade so it can be smothered out with a thick, lush lawn. However, if there was crabgrass in the lawn last summer it will soon be germinating and chemical weed control must be applied before germination. Crabgrass herbicide is in-


