

# Stacey Hurley wins four of six matches

One of the best weekends for Georgetown's Stacey Hurley, a top ranked Canadian tennis player who attends GDHS, took place at an invitational round-robin tournament at Mayfair North tennis club in Toronto.

For the first time in her life, Hurley was competing in the 16 and under category. She is only 15 years old.

Hurley's tactical play and stamina to outlast six matches gave her a record of four wins and two losses, good enough to give her an overall second place finish

for the two-day tournament. **BIG WIN**

In Hurley's first match she met the tough Fatina Ravat, who is seeded number one in Canada in the 16 and under category.

Hurley dominated court play to give her an impressive victory, by 6-3, 0-6, 7-5 scores.

This was the first time Hurley had ever beaten Ravat in competition, which made the victory very more

important.

In the second match, Hurley served well to overpower her opponent, Karen Barberio from Scarborough in straight sets, 6-4 and 7-6.

Hurley went into her third match with a 2-0 record, but met Denice Barberio also from Scarborough and lost in two straight sets, 1-6, 4-6.

Hurley then had to face the very powerful Jill Heatherington, the number

one Canadian in the 14 and under category.

Hurley was never really in this match as she was downed 2-6, 0-6.

Hurley was by no means out of the competition however as she went into her fifth match still feeling very confident

She kept herself together and totally dominated Tony Thomas, of Oakville in straight sets, 6-1, 6-3.

It too was the first time Hurley had even beaten Thomas in 10 games.

In the final match of the tournament, Hurley was faced with a must win situation.

The games went the full two out of three against Joanne Rak of Hamilton.

Hurley did not let up and kept hitting the ball to make her opponent make the mistakes to take the victory, 2-6, 6-2, and 6-2.
