Vacation Guide

Canada--so much to go for

Package vacations are a great way to see Canada, and this year there are more of them than ever. The Canada; So Much To Go For program, a joint effort by the Canadian Government Office of Tourism and private industry to encourage Canadians to travel at home, is offering 80 package tours from five private-industry partners. The partners are Air Canada, CP Air, VIA Rail Canada, Hospitalite Tours-Quebecair and Pacific Western-Transair.

Want to see the rocky fjords of Newfoundland? VIA Rail offers the 10-day Newfoundland Venturer tour which includes all the sights and incredible scenery of Canada's newest province. plus a train ride to and from Montreal and a quick look at Nova Scotia, where you catch the ferry to Newfoundland. A rental car, when you arrive, ensures the flexibility to do and see what you want - historic St. John's, rugged Gros Morne National Park

and rustic fishing villages. Cost from Montreal is \$400. How about the sunny wheatfields of Sasktatchewan? A unique way to see this province is the Pacific Western-Transair Saskpass tour which allows unlimited bus travel anywhere in Saskatchewean for seven days (49). An alternative is a Saskpass tour where you stay in selected hotels in any of five Saskatchewan cities for \$149 per person, based on double occupancy. Saskatchewan is known for its hospitality, so prepare to meet lots

of friendly people. The soaring mountains and . spectacular scenery of British Columbia and western Alberta inspire more tours than almost any other region. Air Canada, CP Air, VIA Rail and Pacific Western-Transair together have at least 20. They usually start and end in Vancouver, Victoria or Calgary and include the Rocky Mountains high spots - Banff, Jasper and other national and provincial parks, the eerie Athabasca Glacier, beautiful Lake Lou ise and various hot springs resorts. Most feature bus travel for the main part of the journey with prices ranging from around \$235 to \$800 (based on double occupancy and depending on the season) for nine to 14 days.

The four big entertainment spots in central Canada --Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal and Quebec City - are also featured in numerous tours. Air Canada's nine-day City Highlights package is one example.

Your trip starts with two nights at the Royal York Hotel in Toronto where you can visit the Ontario Science Centre, the Royal Ontario Museum, Ontario Place, the huge ultra-modern Eaton Centre and the numerous theatres that keep Toronto constantly entertained. Then it's on to Ottawa, Canada's capital, by train, for two nights at the beautiful new Inn of the Provinces. You're within walking distance of the Parliament Buildings. Rideau Canal, National Arts Centre and Sparks Street Mall.


From there you fly to Quebec City, one of Canada's oldest and most historically. significant cities, for a couple of nights at the Hilton. The last part of the trip is two days in Montreal, an exciting place by anyone's standards. Total cost from Toronto is \$315.

Similar tours from VIA Rail and CP Air feature different highlights (Niagara Falls, Chateau Montebello or Sherbrooke) and alternative modes of travel, but most include the same major ciies. Check around to see which package most appeaks to you.

Hospitalite Tours-Quebecois concentrate on the province of Quebec featuring everything from cozy weekends in Montreal or Quebec City to six-days trips through te Gaspe Peninsula or the Laurentians.

Many, such as the Quebec City and Laurentian Resorts package, offer the best of both urban and rural. The basic tour is two days and nights exploring the excitement of Quebec City with two more days of relaxing fun at Manoir du Lac Delage in the Laurentians. (You have the option of adding nights in Quebec City). As with most Hospitalite Tours-Quebecair packages, prices depend on which of three categories of hotel you choose. For the very best, prices start at \$124 per person based on double occupancy; for more conventional accommodation, \$104.

Air Canada's North of 60 Tour, CP Air's Adventure Routes and Pacific Western Transair's Capital City Tour (which includes Whitehorse and Yellowknife among their capital-city starting points) appeal to more adventurours travellers with unbeliebable trips through the incredible scenery of northern Canada. For a touch of the unusual, try golfing under the midnight sun in the Northwest territories, panning for gold in the Yukon or bussing into



World Highway. Other trips go to northern parts of the provinces for a glimpse oif of the unique attractions and scenery these areas offer.

Other packages, such as CP Air's Camper Canada Routes, allow complete freedom to go where and when you want. CP Air flies you to Vancouver, Edmonton, Calgary or Toronto where you pick up a camper or motor home and go wherever you please for eight days, It's ideal for families. Prices start at \$211 including air fare.


