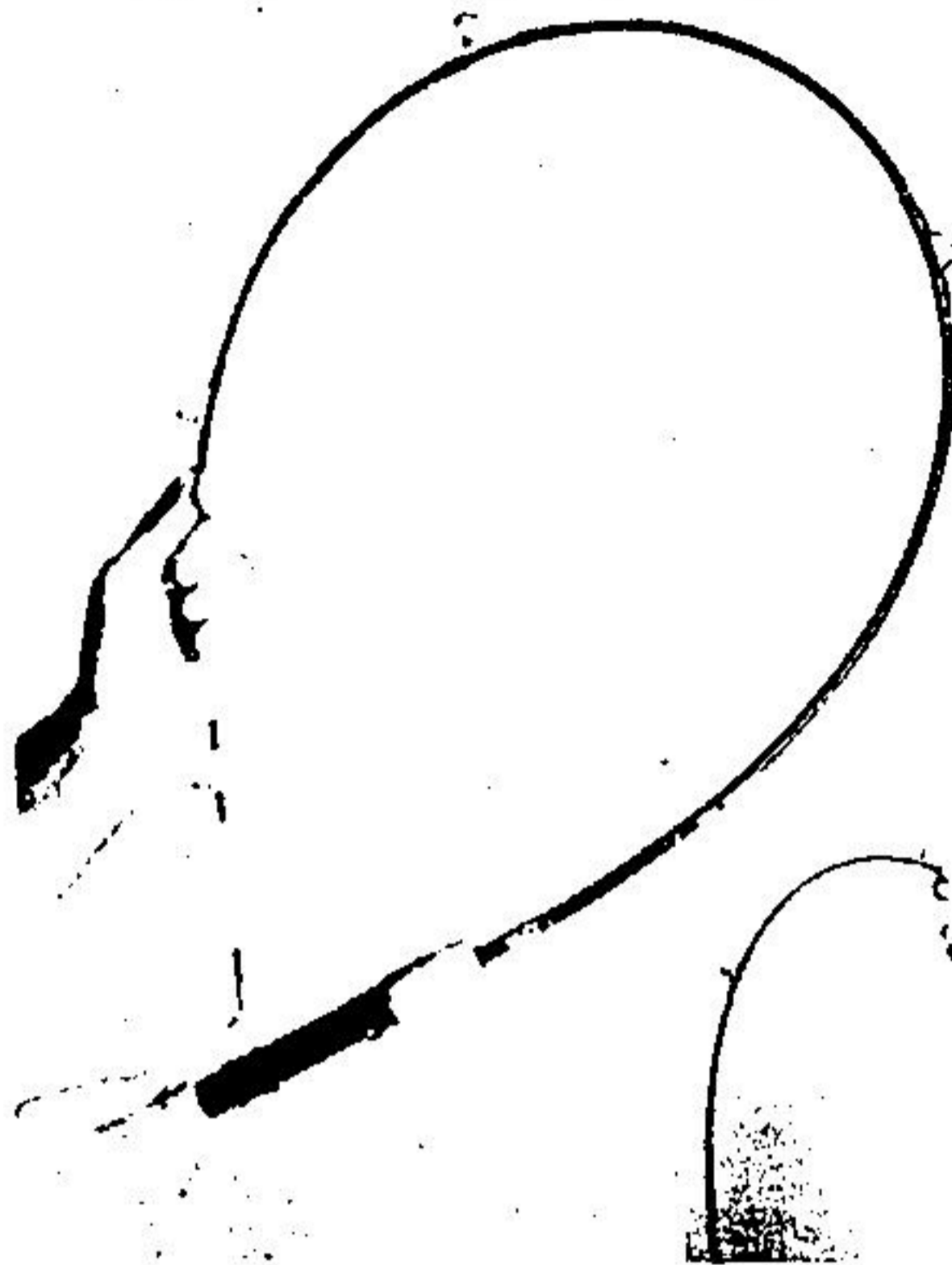
A BEESPACE
