## Handy intends to resign - as Raider general manager

Jack Handy, general manager of the Georgetown Raiders for the past two seasons, has apparently handed in his resignation to team president Bob Hooper.

In a conversation with The Herald Handy said he has handed in his resignation because his job will take up more of his time next year and also because he felt he did not contribute too much this past year.

"Although we won the league championship I felt I did not do too much last year," Handy said. "I don't think I want to return to the post next year,"

Handy also cited the recent arena rental hikes by the Town of Halton Hills as a reason for his decision.

"The rent hikes really ticked me off," he said. "It seems you work hard to accomplish something and the more you do the more

they want."

Handy said he may want to serve in some capacity with the Raiders, but not as general manager.

As high points of his two years as the team's general manager Handy pointed out the two international games the Raiders have played. In 1977 they hosted the Yugoslavians and early this year the Austrians paid a visit to Alcott Arena.

Hooper said he received a letter from Handy last week, but that he has not had a chance to look at it yet.

When informed that the letter was Handy's resignation as general manager, Hooper said he had not had a chance to read it.

"Would you like to see Jack Handy back as the Raider general manager?" Hooper was asked.

"I would like to see Jack

working in some capacity with the Raiders," he answered. "However, the executive was just elected last week, so we will have to have a meeting to see who does what."

There was also a rumor that the new executive would have a committee, as opposed to one man, handling so-called general manager's duties next year.

"We will have one person performing the general manager's duties next year," the president said.

"Is there a chance the president will be acting in a dual capacity?"

"Yes, there is a possibility of that happening," Hooper said. "But the new executive won't be making those kinds of decisions until the middle of July."

Hooper was the teams' general manager in the 1975-76 and 1976-77 seasons.
