Mrs. Scott was born and raised in Norval and came to Georgetown when she married more than 50 years ago.

Her new job gives her the chance to help others by dispensing information on any number of services available to senior citizens and the dis-

Mrs. Scott passes on names and telephone numbers to people needing anything from information on how to apply for a senior citizen apartment to how to get meals delivered through meals-on-wheels.

SILVERWOOD NEWS Mrs. Scott used to write the Silverwood news for the local papers and still belongs to the Silverwood Women's Institute. the Georgetown Horticultural Society and the Georgetown Rug Hooking Guild. Although she no longer records rainfall measurements for the Department of Transport she still keeps her own records. She used to deliver mail on a Georgetown rural route and also worked with the dietician at the Georgetown hospital for a couple of years.

Mrs. Scott can help clients prepare forms in their own home but because she hasn't got her own car she isn't doing so at present.

"You'd be surprised how many people won't even tell me their name when they call," she said, "let alone give me anything they consider to be private information. But I'm sworn to secrecy so there's no way I could tell anyone. Their names don't matter though, as long as I'm helping people."






