## Spring start for art complex

Town council has endorsed a contract retaining Keith Wag- . land and Associates for archilectural services related to the new theatre-library-arts complex proposed for construction on the sile of the Georgetown public library

According to a proposed schedule for the \$1.5 million

project, construction should begin late next spring to transform the historic Church Street building housing the hbrary into a sprawling, twostorey cultural facility. Preliminary designs should be ready by October, detailed drawings by February and approv-

ed tenders by March In accepting the contract and authorizing the preparation of a corresponding bylaw, council last Tuesday night agreed that Mr. Wagland will be responsible for the facility's acoustics and, where applicable, its preservation as an




