Grave change

The town's general committee has responded favourably to an Acton resident's impassioned but policy-breaking request to have the body of his late son repositioned in its grave so that it occupies a full double plot.
The bereaved resident initially sought permission to simply erect a single gravestone over the double family plot at Acton's Fairview Cemetery where his son was buried last November, but was told by deputy treasurer Grant Usher and superintendent of general services Alf Doby that the move contravenes policy and is impossible to allow.
Instead, the resident asked permission to have his son's casket disinterred and then re-interred at the centre of the double plot, the other half of which was apparently purchased in 1966 with the intention of accommodating the deceased and a wife. The deceased man, however, died a bachelor, according to Coun. Ed Wood.
IGNORE RED TAPE: Coun. Wood asked the committee Monday night to ignore the red tape which threatened to prevent the Acton resident from having the casket exhumed and re-located. There have been no objections to the proposed move, he pointed out, from the Medical Officer of Health, nor from the government's Cemetery Branch.
Town engineer Bob Austin referred to town policy which suggested that males are usually buried on the left side of the grave, when viewed facing the headstone, and females on the right. He also cited a precedent in 1975, when town council denied a similar request, but admitted that he knows "of no firm reason why the request" cannot be granted.
The committee voted to allow the resident to re-locate the casket at his own expense.

Council adopts water report

Town council has adopted the results of three consultants' studies which evaluate the current and future water and sewer situations in Georgetown and Acton.
The decision last Tuesday night followed some intensive debate over the importance of the documents, first submitted to Halton region's public works committee and examined in detail by the Herald last spring.
Town councillors were concerned over their ability to comprehend the technical aspects of the reports prepared by the Proctor and Redfern Group, Hydrology Consultants Ltd. and International Water Consultants Ltd.
In response to council's direction, town staff ascertained that Hydrology Consultants Ltd. is willing to send a representative at no charge to explain details of the firm's report on Georgetown's groundwater situation. Council would have to pay a substantial fee to have officials of the other firms attend a future meeting, however.
Similarly, regional officials have declined to send their own staff to assist Halton Hills in reviewing the reports. Council, as a result, voted to simply adopt the reports as submitted. There was no indication that further action will be taken.
The comprehensive documents assess the availability of both groundwater and sewage treatment capacity in Acton and Georgetown both at present and in the future. Alternative methods of accommodating possible shortages in the future, along with cost estimates, are provided.
