In the last three games of Ladies Powderpuff ball,

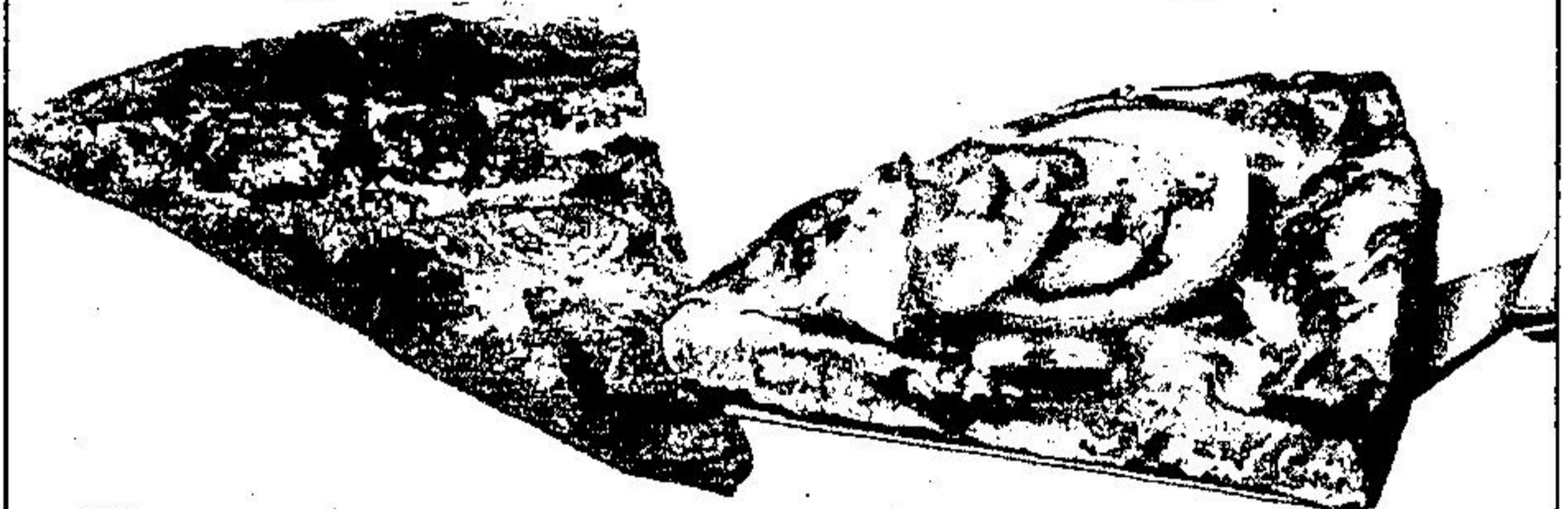
