

Last cricket game of season a win for Georgetown

In two previous encounters London had won each time, and while the London team was not their strongest, the Georgetown team had a point to prove. This was the last game of the season and it was important to try and keep the undefeated streak of 8 games going.

London won the toss and batted. Both batsmen got off the mark quickly, stealing sharp singles however still in the first over Windsor was unlucky in having both batsmen dropped, the first at second slip and then behind the wicket. Neither catch was hard, but it seemed that the Georgetown fielders were flat.

M. Seedial with his first ball removed Williams off stump with a fast, well pitched ball and Georgetown settled down. Windsor took two wickets in his third over with a caught and bowled,

and LBW. Seedial bowled well but had a tendency to drop the ball a little short at times, however he will be a welcome addition for next year.

EXPERIMENT WORKED
With the score at 22, Windsor bowled the London captain Turko and N. Samaroo bowling off breaks took the wicket of Bardai to make the score 27-5 in only 12 overs. Captain Jahoor then did some experimenting using Mongru and Soloman Tankoo who haven't bowled in a game before, and they both justified the move by taking wickets. Mongru took the wicket of Wright and with the help of a nice catch by Dean, and N. Samaroo quickly bowled Pinnock and Askie in one of his best bowling spells ever, taking 4 wickets for 7 runs in 4 overs.

The last wicket to fall was that of Jattan, who although a Georgetown member, played

for London as they were one short. As it turned out Jattan was the fourth highest scorer for London, before he was bowled by his uncle, Tancoo. London were all out for 50, which apparently was the lowest score made by London in 5 years.

Jahoor engaged in further experimentation putting Clyde Samaroo and Larry Hopkins to open the innings and once again it worked. While Hopkins was out at 12, it was off a well hit ball that was nicely caught low down at mid-off, stopping certain four.

Clyde Samaroo played very well making some lovely shots, particularly with hooks and leg glances. Seedial and he took the score to 35 when they were both asked to retire to give someone else a chance to bat.

Dean made some niggly

shots before being bowled, and Tancoo looked very comfortable playing on the front foot hitting the ball very hard, before giving a catch for his back foot.

Mongru put the game away with a hook for 4 and a pull for 6 to pass the London total for the loss of 3 wickets. It was a nice way to end the season and stretched the un-


defeated streak to 9 games.



The weather-protected entry leads into a generous reception foyer and closet storage area which faces the curved stairway up to the main living level, opening into the spacious L-shape living-dining room combination. The living room features a charming front-facing bow window and a corner-positioned, cantilevered-hearth masonry fireplace. The dining room features sliding glass doors to a wide rear patio.

A well-planned U-shape kitchen divides the formal dining room from the more casual dinette area for excellent separation of entertainment dining and relaxed family meals.
