



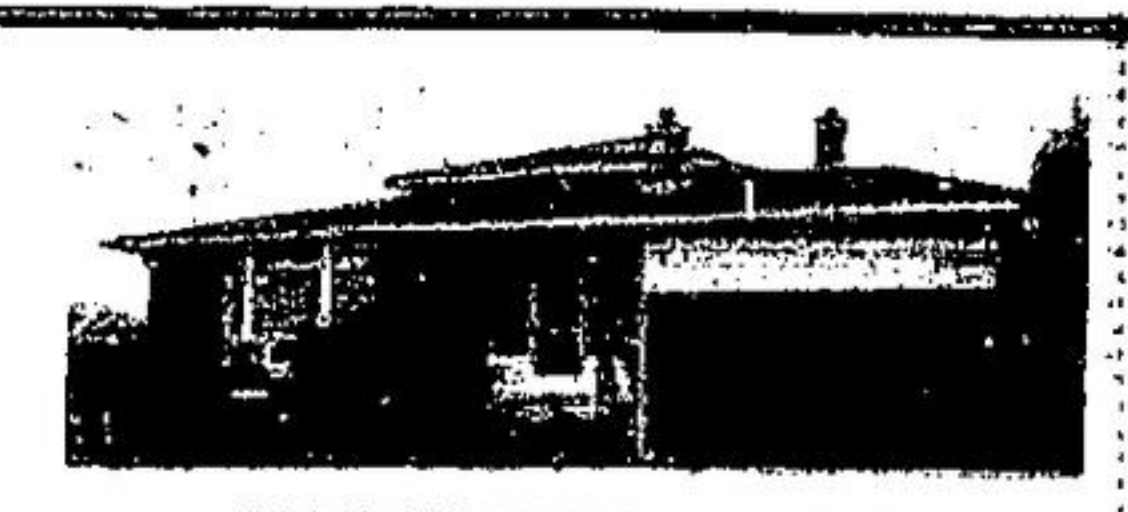
60TH ANNIVERSARY
