Georgetown is a popular place for the making of feature films

Maybe it would be a little presumptuous to really start calling Georgetown "Hollywood North" but, considering its size this town is a popular spot to make feature films.

Since 1976, three major motion pictures have been made in Georgetown. Equus, which starred Richard Burton, was filmed here in November of 1976 and released in the fall of 1977.

In September of 1978, the movie crews were back, this time to film Runaway, starring

Most recently and also, most dramatically, the film Never Trust An Honest Thief was made here this summer to the delight of most local residents. The movie starred film legend Orson Welles along with rising

next spring. One almost wonders why the producers choose Georgetown to make their movies because in all three instances, as soon as the film crews hit town, they started changing it.

MAJOR IMPACT

However, no film had an impact on Georgetown like Never Trust An Honest Thief. For the entire month of August

and part of September Georgetown almost ceased to exist. In its place rose up Madison, New York. Again, Georgetown was a small town, this time near the Canada-US border. For almost the entire stay of the film crew in town a festival atmosphere prevailed as the

bright red, white and blue flags and bunting, supposedly part of US July 4 celebrations, decorated much of the town and helped bring smiles to the faces of local residents.

The highlight of the film crew's stay in town had to be the biggest party this town has ever seen, the shooting of the July 4 parade scenes on August

19 and 20. The film's producers invited the entire town to come out and partake in free hot

dogs, roast beef and pop, along with free T-shirts and, the parade itself. From the crowds

that jammed the town's Main Street and the Fairgrounds, it

seemed like everyone took them on their invitation.

While it is difficult to pin down the reason for Georgetown's popularity as a movie

setting, one of the main reasons seems to be that while the
