ICG launches appeal

In a final, two-pronged assault, the Interested Citizens' Group (ICG) is continuing its battle against the controversial 500,000-volt hydro transmission corridor.

The ICG intends to send a second appeal to the provincial cabinet, opposing the Ontario Municipal Board's decision that approved the corridor, and will also prepare a submission for next week's town council meeting.

Council is expected to ratify the recent planning board decision rezoning land along the town's Fifth Concession, allowing Hydro to complete the 109-mile transmission corridor linking the Bruce Nuclear Station to the Milton switching station.
