**Book Review**

**Dieppe book not for children**

More than thirty years after it happened, the Canadian army's Dieppe raid of Aug. 19, 1942, continues to get attention from the media, and some strange things are said.  
Recently a columnist in a national magazine distinguished himself by writing a page about it under the heading that included the phrase "myths of bravery and pluck." This was the first time, to my knowledge, that anyone had suggested that bravery at Dieppe was a myth.  
The Canadian Broadcasting Corporation rediscovers Dieppe every few years, and has an orgy about it. The latest of these: This year on Remembrance Day and the following, with two television programs, long in preparation, being presented.  
A by-product has appeared in what may be called by courtesy a book: Dieppe 1942: Echoes of Disaster (Thomas Nelson and Sons; 189 pages; \$14.95).  
It has no title-page to tell who wrote it, but from the dust-cover (until it is lost or thrown away) the reader may learn that the author, apparently, is William Whitehead, while Terence Macartney-Filgate is the "editor."  
This is a picture-book, recalling the picture-books of child-

hood, but many of the pictures presented here are not suitable for children. It seems to be intended for people who can't read, or who read only with difficulty.  
The letter-press, what there is of it, is all in very large type (sometimes, almost what newspapermen are said they call "Second Coming" type).  
**ABATTLEWON**  
Thus the late Lord Mountbatten, who was as Chief of Combined Operations had more responsibility for the raid than any other individual and was evidently interviewed for the TV programs, is quoted, letters a quarter of an inch high, as saying, "The Duke of Wellington said that the Battle of Waterloo was won on the playing fields of Eton, and I say that the Battle of Normandy was won on the beaches of Dieppe."  
Many opinions from other people about the operation are quoted, but unfortunately we are very seldom told who the people were.  
That Dieppe was a bloody failure is hardly news. The authors say, "The very word Dieppe chills the hearts of an entire generation of Canadians." This is an exaggeration, but his book is clearly intended to make it reality if it can.  
The Germans took innumerable photographs for propaganda purposes after the raid: pictures of dead Canadians (and these were terribly numerous), of Canadian wounded, of Canadians as prisoners.  
I don't know how many

pictures the Germans took, but it is fairly evident that Whitehead and Macartney-Filgate have printed every one they could find - by my count, 74. So repetitious are they that they defeat their own purpose, which is evidently to make our flesh creep.  
**IMPUTING BLAME**  
Some bad books have been written about Dieppe. This is probably not the worst of them, though the reader may have gathered that I find myself reacting against it.  
It is not free from an unpleasant tendency of some other writers, including the columnist about mentioned, who, not content with imputing bad judgement to those who made what I agree was a bad plan, feel that they must also imply that they had respectable motives.  
Our present authors write, in their wisdom, "Perhaps, if blame is to be assigned, it must be shared by everyone involved in the raid on Dieppe - by those who planned it, for

their mistakes; by those who fought in it, for their inexperience; and by those who wanted it in the first place, for their inability to resist playing the military and political game of war."  
The mistakes must be admitted; but inexperience is hardly a crime; and the reference to "those who wanted it in the first place," with its vague apparent imputation of frivolity to unnamed people, seems to me baseless and reprehensible.
