The Royal Winter Fair isn't much of a break for dairy cattlemen competing in the show.

"The work still has to be done whether you're here or at home on the farm," Ken McNabb of Georgetown said this week.

Ken and father John are at the Royal this week hoping to win some ribbons in Guernsey breed competition.

Twice a day, the six cows the McNabbs have at the show have to be milked.

"It's inconvenient compared to our routine at home," Ken says, "but we're here to publicize our herd and to make sales and that's why we show."

The inconvenience, as Ken puts it, has paid off for the McNabbs.

In the past two years, one of their entries has been chosen grand champion cow. They have won four firsts in the last five years of showing and in 1976 and 1978, won the breeders' herd award. In total, they have placed nine firsts in four years.

Ken, who recently completed a bachelor of science in agriculture at the University of Guelph, has returned to the family farm, Callumlea Guernseys on Trafalgar Road, to take an active role.

While many graduate students chose a management branch of farming Ken says he gets the best of both worlds managing a farm operation and actually work-

ing it.

"I am just happy to be part of the family farm operation," Ken said.

## Farmers of the future

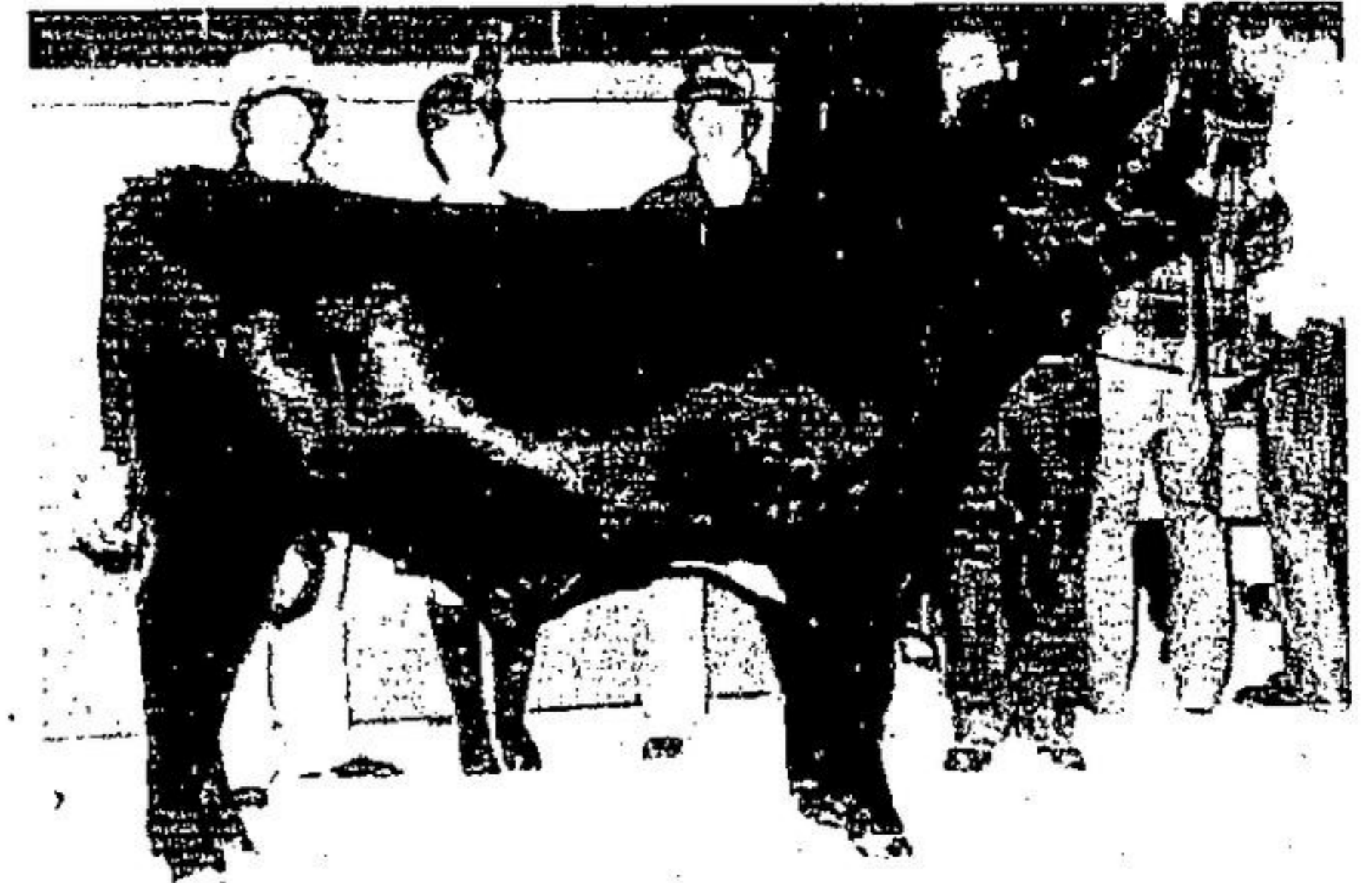
Numerous Halton youngsters participated in the 51st Royal Agricultural Winter Fair during the past two weeks.
