

CVCA sets '80 rates

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority (CVCA) approved a new fee structure for the winter and year-round programs at the Terra Cotta Conservation Area for 1980 at its meeting Thursday.

The fee structure was drawn up by the parks and recreation committee the week previous and submitted to the full authority for approval.

Cross-county ski equipment is available at Terra Cotta in a variety of packages. The full ski outfit, including skis, boots and poles can be rented for \$6 for a full day and \$5 for a half day. Skis alone are \$3, poles alone, \$1.50 and boots alone are \$2.50. Ski waxing will cost \$1.50.

An addition to the program will permit groups of cross-country skiers to make reservations for weekdays, and they will pay only for the rental of the equipment. There will be no admission fee charged.

Snowshoes can be rented for \$3 a day, and \$2 for a half-day.

The daily vehicle permit this year will remain at \$3, as will the seasonal vehicle permit of \$25. The walk-in admission is up to 50 cents from 25 cents per day, and the seasonal walk-in admission is \$5.

The daily camping rate will be \$3, and the seasonal camping permit for 30 days will be \$60. Campsites with hydro will be \$7.50 a day. Group camping will cost \$10 a day up to 20 people, and an additional \$10 for an additional 20 people or less. Wood will be sold for \$1.

The bus permit will cost \$20, as will the senior citizens' bus permit. The swimming pool fee has been increased to 50 cents from 25 cents.

Vaughn house up for sale

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority has decided to place the former Vaughn house on the Ninth Line and Sideroad 27 for rent on the open market.

The house had formerly been rented to an employee of the authority who has since moved out. The authority didn't have anyone on its staff who wants to move in, so general manager Glenn Schmitt suggested the house should be rented on the open market for \$200 a month, plus utilities.

Ashgrove for plowing match site

The 1980 Halton Plowing Match will be held at the site of the 1974 International Plowing Match on the farm of W.T. Craig Reid, east of Ashgrove, the Halton Plowmen's Association has decided.

The Association's Dec. 4 meeting saw members agree that an earlier match date should be selected to avoid the cold, wet weather that has accompanied some of the recent events in Halton. Plowmen it was decided, will gather at the Reid farm on 10 Sideroad next Sept. 13.

The Association meeting featured the election of a new slate of officers, headed by president Murray Breckon of Burlington, according to Halton rep Henry Stanley.

Mr. Stanley also reported that several local young people were honored for their 4-H homemaking achievements late last month. Receiving Provincial Honors for completing 12 4-H projects were Elaine Cunningham and Barbara Treviranus of Ashgrove, Anna Edwards of Georgetown and two other girls from Campbellville.

Receiving County Honors were 12 girls, among them Patricia Adams, Kathy Galbraith and Lorie LeRiche of Hornby North, Lisa Morton, Susan Rayner and Judy Speck of Hornby South, Tara Bludd and Cheri Kirby of Georgetown and Lynda Wingfield of Ashgrove.

Topping the list was Betty Marchment of Hornby North, who was presented with an Advanced Honors Certificate and a silver pie server for completing 18 projects.

The Dr. Ethel Chapman scholarship was presented to Marilyn McNabb of Ashgrove by Mrs. John McNabb, president of the Halton District Women's Institute.

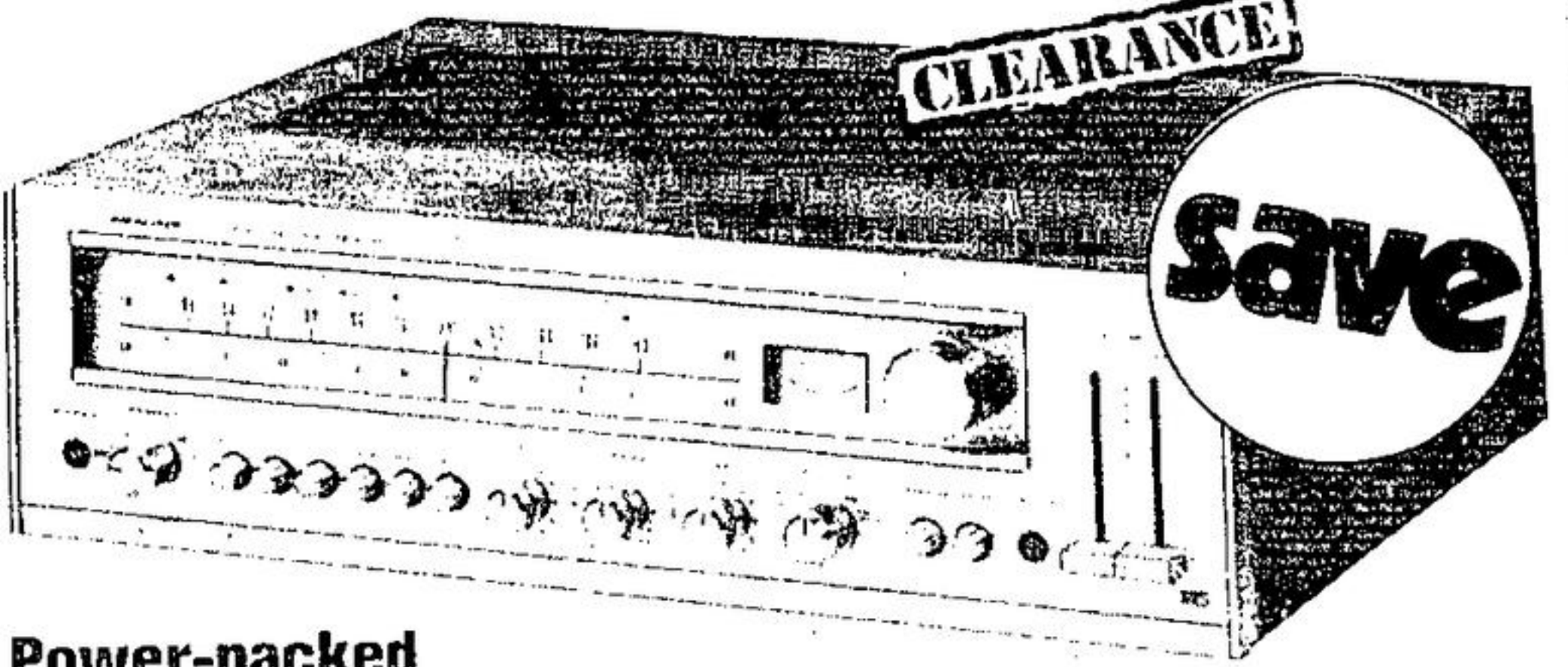
