



## Tree bylaw left stuck on a limb

A long-awaited bylaw that would restrict and regulate the destruction of trees in Halton region has been deferred until regional solicitor Dennis Per-In can perfect the wording.

Regional council approved last week a planning committee recommendation to defer the Halton tree conservation bylaw and instruct Mr. Perlin to meet with the director of planning and prepare a complete report and a suitable draft bylaw to be reviewed at the next committee meeting.

Coun. Roy Booth of Halton Hills, chairman of the committee, said that the solicitor had written him indicating there were a few items in the proposed bylaw, as written, that he could not support.

"We'd like to delay it just a little while until the solicitor can perfect the legal language of the bylaw", Coun. Booth Coun. Laurie Mannell of

Oakville spoke against the deferment. "We've been horsing around

with this tree bylaw since council was formed in 1974 and we still keep sending it back", he said. "Why don't we just forget It."

A "tree", according to the bylaw, is any species of woody


plant which has reached or can reach an average height of at least five metres at physical maturily.
