## Area 2 fire-fighters honored at annual meeting

# Charges await Peel cop

A former Peel regional police detective returned Wednesday from England to Canada to face charges stemming from the theft of property held at a regional police station in Mississauga. Peel police reported last week.

Roy Wood, 41, of Georgetown, has been charged with theft over \$200 and possession of stolen goods over \$200. "He returned voluntarily from England," Peel police Insp. James Wingate said. Mr. Wood was taken into custody at Toronto International Airport Wednesday afternoon by Insp. Wingate and Det. Sgt. Dan Banting.

"We had been contacted by his lawyer, Joseph Kappy of Toronto," Insp. Wingate said.

Mr. Wood was later released after a bail hearing in Brampton provincial court

and remanded until Feb. 1.

Mr. Wood was charged in August after electronic equipment and clothing worth more than \$1,000 disappeared from a property room at 11 Division in Mississauga. A large portion of the property has been recovered.

At the time Mr. Wood was vacationing with his family in England. The family later returned to Canada, but Mr.

Wood remained in England. Mr. Wood, a 15-year police veteran, was suspended from the force and subsequently resigned.

Extradition proceedings were underway at the time of Mr. Wood's return.
