

# Conflict issue still unresolved

Coun. Harry Levy said, Clerk-administrator Ken Richardson noted that, if enough councillors have possible conflicts on an item, it could result in a loss of quorum and necessitate the item's deferral.

"As long as you have a clear conscience, you don't have to worry," Mayor Pomeroy suggested. "I'm not going to change the way I operate and I suggest that council should do the same."

Mr. Steele admitted that the act is badly worded and catches things that it was not intended to catch.

"Asking the province to

change it is not a bad idea; it is too restrictive," he said.

Mr. Steele cautioned the committee, however, that because of penalties which could be imposed, councillors should continue to follow his direction in declaring conflicts of interest.

"(Penalties) could be anything from a fine to the loss of a councillor's seat," Mr. Steele explained.

Coun. Booth asked Mr. Steele whether the actions of council members regarding

the rest home proposal, which precipitated the rash of conflict disclosures, could be brought up at some future date.

"I'd better give that some consideration," Mr. Steele replied.
