

Planning changes underway

Newly revised planning procedures and applications for Halton Hills go into effect Friday.

Town won't restrict trucks

Halton region's public works committee has denied a request by Halton Hills Coun. Russ Miller that truck traffic be restricted along a section of Mountainview Road in Georgetown.

for Ken Richardson, to encourage developers to research their proposals more fully, thereby reducing the processing time for the town.

The revised procedures will be reviewed next September. Under the new procedures, applicants seeking approval for subdivision and condominium plans will have to file draft plans with the ministry of housing or Halton region before the town will open a file on the proposal.

Mr. Richardson said that, previously, plans were presented to planning board by the public, in many instances with little planning or engineering staff input. He contended that in certain cases, this led to pre-judgement of an application and public reaction.

The new procedures only require that council be notified of the application receipt, with no presentation or dialogue on the merits of the application.

When official plan amendments and rezoning applications are filed with the clerk's office, notice will be given to council and the applications will be referred to staff, with no presentation of the application until a full staff report has been prepared.

COMMITTEE ENDORSES INCREASED EXEMPTION

The town's general committee is recommending to council that it re-endorse an Organization of Small Urban Communities proposal that the income tax exemption for freighters be increased from \$300 to \$1,000. A report from the OSUM noted that provision for an increase from \$300 to \$500 had been made in the recently defeated federal budget.

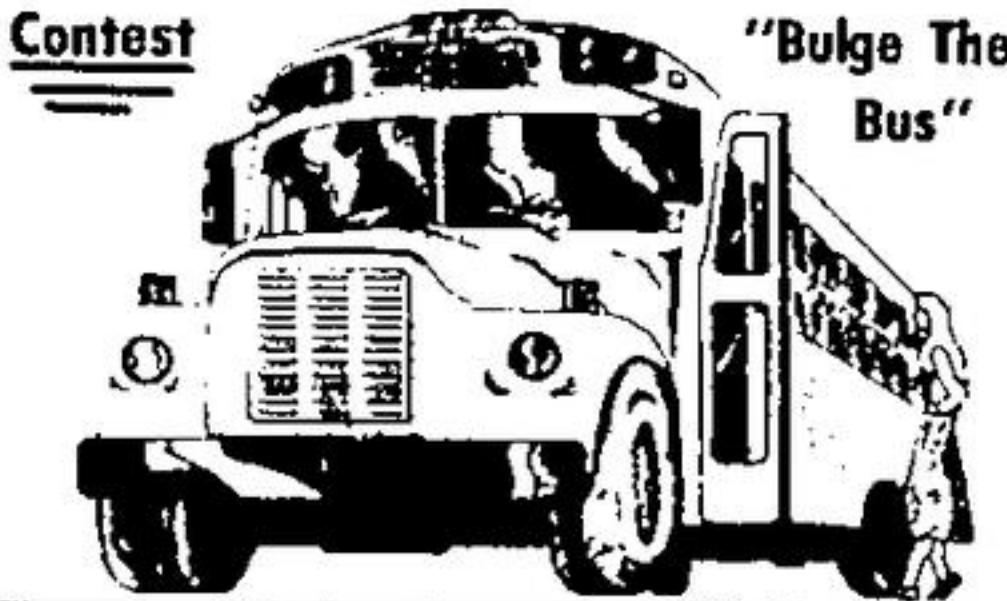
