North American camping excitement

"Get to know your own backyard", that's the message coming in loud and clear from many experts in the travel business this year.

With inflation and our devalued dollar there's a great deal to be said for this philosophy. Canada and the U.S. have this year become attractive and inexpensive tourist destinations. If you add to this "the twist" of organized camping, you have the most exciting new way to see North America.

Camping isn't merely an economical way of travelling around; it's a lot more fun. Today there is a growing group of adventurous young travellers from all over the world who agree that the challenge offers excitement as well as economy.

This summer groups of camping travellers will be heading off in many directions - across Canada, to the east coast, through the American west, or north to the Yukon and Alaska - by coach or comfortable minibus, tenting as they go, making personal journeys of discovery.

Goway Travel of Toronto, which has been in the business of developing camping travel longer than any other organization in North America, offers a series of vacation trips ranging from 40 day bus camping vacations

across Canada and the United States to a quickie one-way Trans Continental between Toronto and Vancouver in just 13 days!

In contrast to the hectic pace of some motor-coach tours, certainly not to be compared, these camping trips try to include most, if not all, of the famous and familiar scenes and sights. Activities vary from panning for gold in the Klondike to surf and sun on a Californian beach.

These are opportunities to go rafting on the Fraser River, stay on a Prairie farm, and hayride, trek into the Grand Canyon, and go clam digging on the Atlantic shores.

trip price eg: entrance to Disneyland attractions, Universal City Film Studios, Navajo Tribal Lands, Sears Observation Tower, etc. So the "extras" which can creep

up on a traveller's bunkroll are kept to an absolute minimum. A very important point for young travellers.
