

Deer hunt approved despite volatile opposition

A controlled deer hunt will be held in Halton Region this November despite the determined opposition of some regional council members.

The hunt, set for November 3, 4 and 5, was approved following a volatile debate at council last Wednesday.

While all councillors agreed that area farmers who say they are suffering crop and livestock damage due to a growing deer population have a right to protection, many disagreed that a controlled hunt, as described by Gary Tuppiling of the ministry of natural resources, is the proper method of action.

Milton Mayor Don Gordon expressed concern that 25 per cent of the hunters, to be selected by lottery, would come from outside the region.

Coun. Roy Booth of Halton Hills said the hunt is necessary not only because of the damage to farms, but because car accidents involving deer have increased dramatically in recent years, coinciding with the increase of the deer population.

"In 1970, there were 12 accidents involving deer in Halton Region and in 1979, this increased to 82," he said.

Coun. Joan Allingham of Burlington said she sympathiz-

ed with the farmers' problems, but felt that basically what the region is saying is "let the

hunters get them before the cars do".

Coun. Booth responded that

deer are getting into accidents because they're searching for food, which becomes scarce as

population increases, and that many of the accidents don't kill the deer immediately, but

cause them great pain and suffering.

The hunt will be organized

by the region in co-operation with the ministry of natural resources.
