Oakville singer featured

Choral Society concert Sunday evening

DOREEN WILFORD, a Midland native who now lives in Oakville, will be guest soprano soloist with the Georgetown Choral Society, joining north Halton soloists Bill Brush, Carolyn Simmons and George De Kleeer, for next week's Beethoven concert.

In early years of school, Mrs. Wilford was introduced to music both at home and at school. A younger sister to three girls already singing together as a trio, Doreen soon caught up to make the threesome a quartet. Concert appearances and competitive singing in festivals was a part of this quartet's fun-loving youth.

Mrs. Wilford studied voice as a child and soared to the senior church choir at the age of 12 years. The ensuing years followed this pattern of church singing and basic choral techniques. In 1957, she moved to Oakville and became affiliated with St. John's United Church choir.

Around this time, Mrs. Wilford became soloist at St. Andrew's United Church in Toronto, which lasted five years, followed by three years as soloist with United Church of Truth. Heading towards home ground, Doreen took up soloist duties with her own church, St. John's in Oakville, where she is currently active.

Our featured singer studied voice with Charles Kilgour of Oakville and studied four years opera with former opera singer Juliana Zorzi.

Musical theatre captured Mrs. Wilford's interest and she joined Clarkson Music Theatre. For several years, this association continued, and at the same time, Doreen sang with St. Anne's Gilbert and Sullivan Society, as well as Toronto Gilbert and Sullivan Society in lead roles. One year with Abbey Players Limited of Brampton in a Gilbert and Sullivan role drew the public's attention including that of some Georgetown music enthusiasts.

More recently, she performed in Night Visitors at the Oakville Centre, playing the role of mother. All in all, Doreen Wilford has been featured in 23 full productions. Looking back over the years, this musician recollected singing oratorio music with St. George's Boys' Choir as soloist at Kingston, Ontario. In a different vein, Mrs. Wilford has sung at conventions with a band.

To accentuate Mrs. Wilford's versatility in the arts, The Herald learned she has had eight years' experience modelling combined with singing in the Toronto area. After being contracted to sing and model for the Canadian Pool and Patio show, she took a crash modelling course which has led to many singing-modelling jobs in this field of promotion.

Turning to yet another activity this busy musician fits

into her tight schedule culinary craft and she says she "enjoys cooking". When she can find time, Mrs. Wilford also is a pastel artist and she sews most of her own clothes as well as working on crewel handwork and crochet to have more time for someday.

Doreen Wilford told The Herald she has enjoyed her association with the Georgetown Choral Society.

"I enjoy whatever I am doing at the time," she commented.

Doreen brings her expertise to Halton Hills when she performs Beethoven's Mass in C Major with the Choral Society and Oakville Symphony Saturday night at Holy Cross Church in Georgetown.

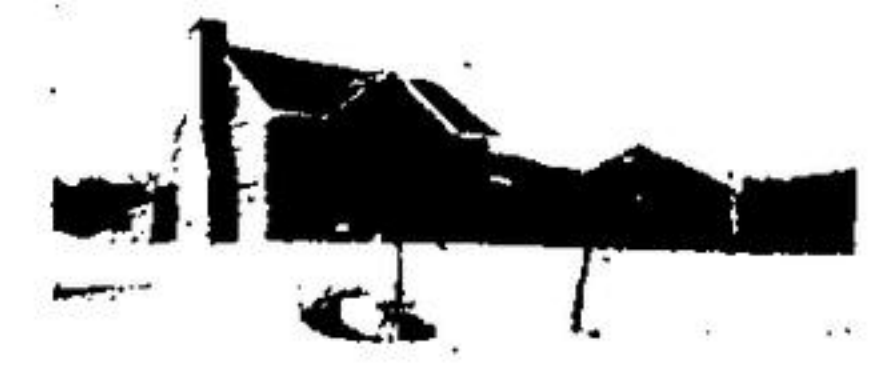
