Homeowner loans approved for town

 Halton Hills has government approval to set aside \$40,000 for loans to homeowners under the Ontario Home Renewal Program.

Under the program, a homeowner who occupies the property he plans to upgrade may apply for a maximum of \$7,500 deputy-clerk Delmar French said.

The town will decide on the combination of forgivable loans and repayable loans. Not more than \$4,000 may be forgiven.

The program aim is to help owners to repair homes to standards developed locally and acceptable to the ministry. Particular emphasis is placed

on rehabilitating substandard dwellings with faulty structural and sanitary conditions and to the upgrading of plumbing, insulation, heating and electrical systems.

Loans are available to families whose "adjusted family income" does not exceed \$12,500.

The loans are aimed at repairing, not adding frills. Such things as second bathrooms, garages and recreation rooms won't qualify for loans. Nor may the owner re-finance existing loans or encumbrances. This does not mean that an owner paying a loan or a mortgage can't get a loan. All he must do is be able to meet both the loan payments and his other payments too.

Salaries hiked

While Halton region's administration and finance committee managed to spend several minutes debating the merits of a \$10 boy scout membership during discussion of its 1980 operating budget, it spent no time at all on an eight per cent salary increase for regional councillors.

Committee began the arduous work of trimming the budget last week and succeeded in approving the budget approval schedule, plus making limited head-counts in the operating budget for regional chairman Jack Rafis. Committee approved the membership.

Committee did manage to make some substantial reductions, trimming travel expenses for councillors from a requested \$13,200 to \$7,200.

The budget for the chairman's office furnishings was reduced from a requested \$1,100 to \$600.

Committee approved the chief administrator's budget for 1980, totalling \$72,300, with no changes way into the content of the

budget itself. All of the budget alterations made by the committee will be reviewed by other regional committees prior to the budget going before council March 26.

When committee went over the operating budget for councillors, no comments were made on the salary increase, which would boost annual wages for regional councillors from \$9,074 to \$10,750.
