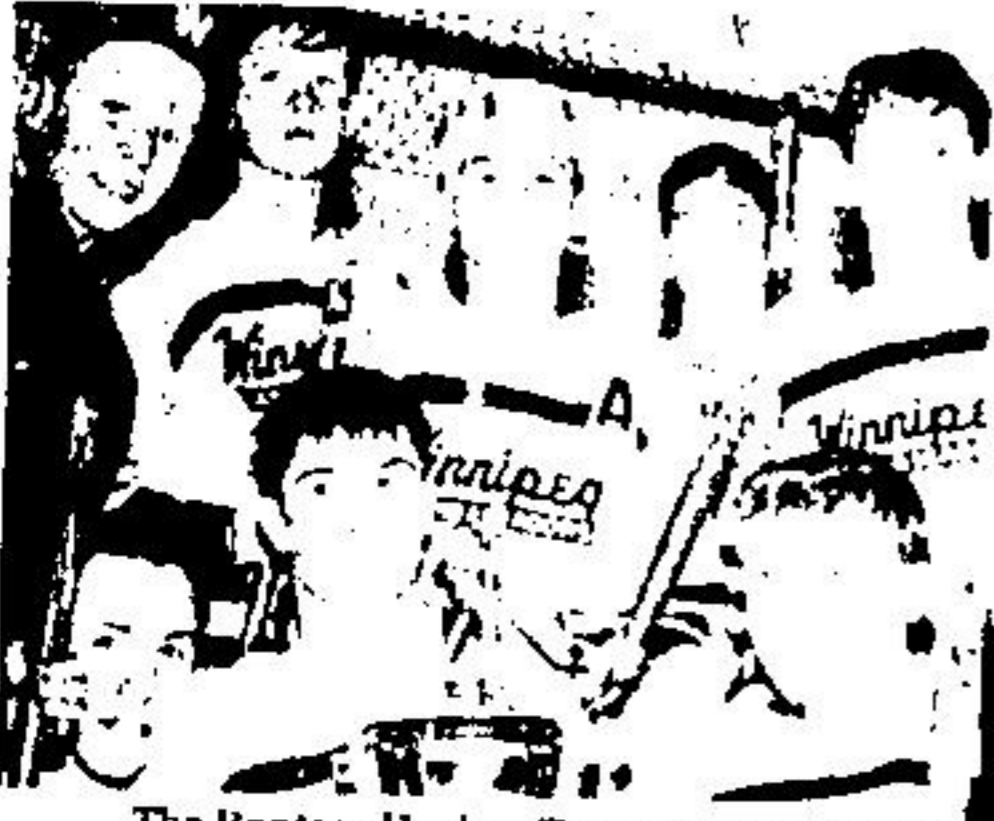
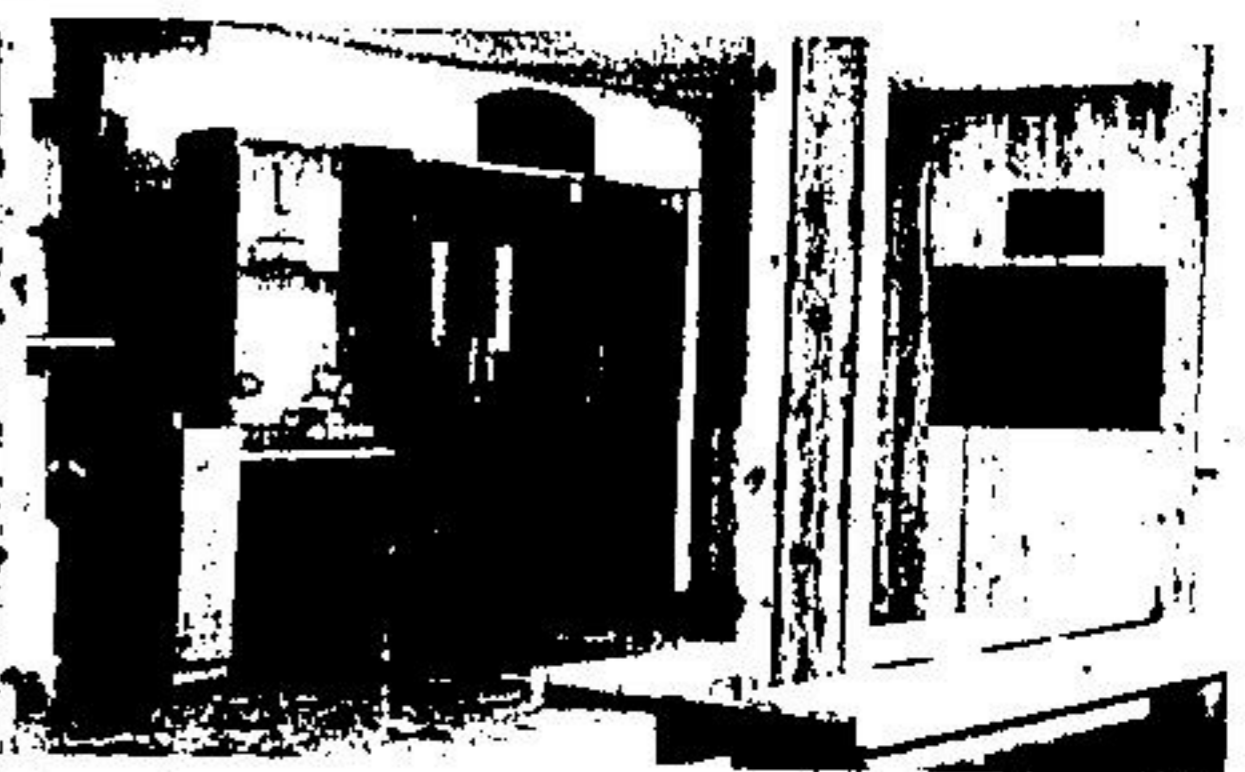
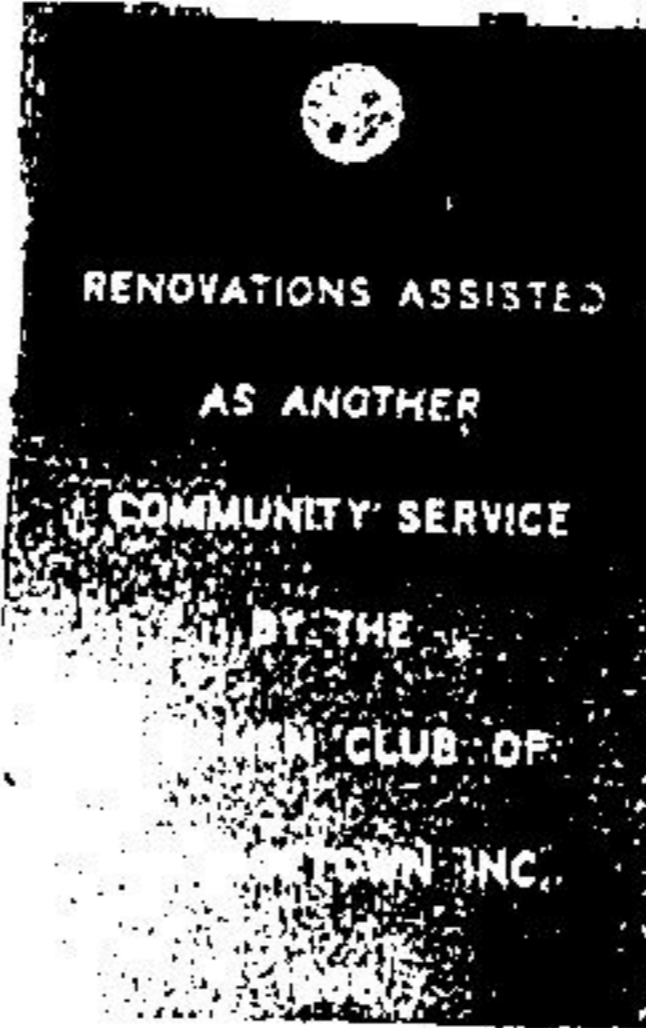


# Kinsmen record tough to beat



## INTERNATIONAL BANTAM HOCKEY TOURNAMENT

The Bantam Hockey Tournament was started in the early 1960s, at which time the Kinsmen looked after entertainment for the teams attending. In 1966, under the direction of Kin Harry Levy, Kinsmen were asked to take the tournament on as a club project, which the club ran for 12 successful years until 1978, at which time, due to a low membership, turned the direction of the tournament over to the Georgetown Lions.



In 1966-67, The Kinsmen set to work to assist in the renovations to Georgetown Memorial Arena and raised \$7,900 which was turned over to the Arena Renovation Committee as another Kinsmen Community Service project.



A modern apartment unit just off Prince Charles Drive bears the Kin name, as it was the Kinsmen who spearheaded the founding and building of the Senior's Apartment. After several locations were chosen by the Kin



committee and submitted. It was finally this site that was chosen. The cost of the residence to Kin was \$18,000, a very worthwhile project. This residence houses 24 separate units and was officially opened in 1970.
