Herring are plentiful and the harvest is watched fairly close. There is no season or limit on them. However, are the amounts of fish taken needed, and are they used? This is the criteria to measure against.

REMEMBER that fish buts have to be off Lake Simcoe by March 15, and this is a Saturday. Make sure that you remove it in good time or heavy fines are levied

for leaving buts past the date.

There is still a lot of good fishing yet, in fact it may be the best of the season, and even after the removal of your huts, you may fish through the ice in the open. This sometimes offers the best fishing of the whole year, and the ice condition may still be good. If not then fish the breaks or open water, watching for safe footing and a good escape route. Don't take too great a chance, but Lake front are sometimes taken on regular spinning tackle when east from the edge of an ice flow. Like I say it is fangerous, but with caution, could be worth the risk. Now I am going to get calls and letters about sending fishermen and to risky places. That is their choice, not mine, and I won't lish this way but it is done every year.

the details of the show.




