

Saturday morning when a Sexton self-propelled gun came lumbering down the road. The vehicle, a Canadian-designed 25-pounder gun mounted on a Ham tank chassis, was on its way to the Canadian Military Historical Society museum at R.R.2, Rockwood, after restoration, Dr. Bill Gregg, owner of the museum, purchased the vehicle after it was found in a scrapyard in Sussex, England. It is believed to be one of the first 100 manufactured in 1913 by the Montreal Locomotive Works.

Drivers on Highway 7 near Acton had to look twice | Dubbed "the Ellminator" by one of its six-man crews, the vehicle was used by the British Army in North Africa. Dr. Gregg, shown with his new acquisition, said he had originally expected to have to take the vehicle to the museum on a float but was well-pleased when it could be driven instead. It was doing about 23 miles per hour Saturday which is almost its top speed. But since it only get .9 miles to the gallon and runs on aircraft fuel it won't be taken for joyrides no matter the thrill of rolling down the open road while all the other drivers rubberneck at the oddity.

Crime prevention is the aim of the Block Parent program

The Block Parent program has been included as one of the programs which will operate with the assistance of the Halton Regional Police crime prevention bureau.

Judy Mara, one of the chairpersons of the Georgetown Block Parent program, said representatives from the Burlington, Oakville and Georgetown programs met with Crime Prevention Officer Sgt. Wayne Jessop and Community Relations Officer Sgt. Norm Ryall last Friday to discuss the Block Parent program.

The program will still deal primarily with the local safety officer, Constable Raj Swaminathin, but will also have liaison with Sgt. Jessop.

A few minor changes in the program, which it is hoped will streamline the operation, have been accepted. The police department will be drawing up a regional application form for membership in the Block Parents program, with different colors for the different areas of the region. This will minimize the number of applications which go astray, Mrs. Mara

Mrs. Mara said the Block Parents are considering different possibilities for expanding the program, but the group needs more stability before considering anything too ambitious. There have been problems in putting together an

executive to organize the program over the past year or so.

"We could use more people from the Block Parent Community to come forward and help with the executive re-

sponsibilities, but if we have to do it with two or three people. that's fine," Mrs. Mara said.

Mrs. Mara said the group is considering the possibility of an appreciation dinner in June, "but only if we have enough people to put it togeth-

One of the group's more immediate projects is a possible sign exchange later in the spring, for those Block Parents whose sign is showing its age.






