Markham man is injured in two-vehicle accident

A Markham man is in stable condition in Milton District Memorial Hospital following a two-car accident on Trafalgar Road just south of 5 Sideroad Thursday afternoon.

Albert Kovacs, 33, of Markham, suffered a broken leg and facial lacerations. It collided head-on with the car driven by Mr. Crispo.

Damage to Mr. Crispo's van was estimated at \$2,500. Damage to Mr. Kovacs' car was estimated at \$7,000.

Market assessment

Market value assessment may become an issue again in the town. Coun. Harry Levy requested information from clerk-administrator Ken Richardson on market value assessment at the last general committee meeting, noting that "many municipalities all over the province are going to market value assessment". Coun. Roy Booth pointed out that the town previously passed a motion not to convert to market value assessment which would have to be rescinded. He added that Milton is presently struggling with market value assessment and is facing great problems in implementation. Coun. Ross Knechtel countered that Toronto is presently in seriously financial trouble because they have not looked at market value assessment.
