

Region committee approves \$178,000

Partial 1980 waste program

Halton region will not be getting the full extent of a proposed \$16 million waste control program in 1980, but the region's solid waste management committee is recommending to council that a partial program be implemented at an estimated cost of \$178,000.

Committee passed the recommendation at last

week's meeting under new chairman, Halton Hills Coun. Russ Miller, who replaced Oakville Coun. Terry Mannell. Mannell resigned his post after council referred the committee's \$16 million program back to staff for further study.

When it sent the program back for study in February, council asked staff to come up with a full report on the

program and its implementation.

The region's chief administrative officer, Ernie Reid, presented committee with a preliminary version of that report last week, saying that, due to time limitations, a full report could not be presented for implementation in 1980.

Mr. Reid recommended that a partial program, which would cost \$178,000, be implemented in 1980.

The program would involve a source separation program, a preliminary transfer station

program and a preliminary resource utilization plant program.

The source separation program, estimated at \$33,000, would include a market development program at \$25,000, an evaluation of collection techniques at \$7,000 and the design of a survey questionnaire at \$1,000.

The transfer station program, estimated at \$25,000, would include \$5,000 for market development and site selection in Georgetown, \$15,000 for the preliminary engineering and \$5,000 for the

approvals process.

The resource utilization plant, estimated at \$120,000, includes a \$20,000 market development program and \$100,000 for the preliminary engineering.

All-French Canada

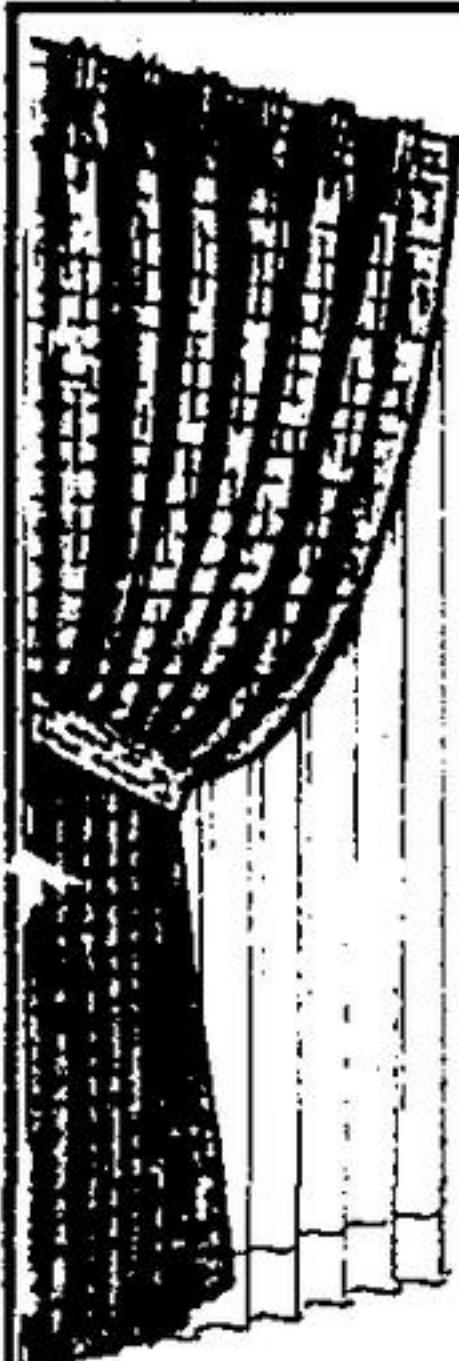

their civil services being changed over to French-Canadian control faster than the eye can follow. The remaining provinces will be similarly converted within the next few years. Billions of dollars of our taxes have been poured into our provinces and into Franco-phone Associations across Canada to achieve that goal, both by our Federal Government and by Quebec itself. Our Federal Government public service, our armed forces, the RCMP, and 429 Crown Corporations including Air Canada, CN, CBC, and CRTC are already firmly in French-Canadian control.

I am suggesting that we stop worrying about Quebec, for Quebec has no intention of leaving the Canada that it already controls. Instead we should now be declaring the nine provinces outside of Quebec to be English-speaking, just as Quebec has declared itself to be French-speaking. Then let Quebec join us on our terms. If not we will be joining Quebec on its terms, and those terms, with Mr. Trudeau as arbiter, mean an all-French Canada.

If I didn't have proof of what was going on in my first book "BILINGUAL TODAY, FRENCH TOMORROW", there is no shortage of proof in my recent book "BACKDOOR BILINGUALISM", where I also suggest how we can put an end to this undeclared war for our country. Our politicians have failed us, and now it is up to Canadians themselves. Either we move now or we might as well learn to say "Yes sir" in French.
