NHAMR may buy Sunshine school

The North Halton Association for the Mentally Retarded has approached the Halton Board of Education about either buying Sunshine School at Hornby for a nominal amount or leasing it for a nominal sum.

The board will close the school in June and send its students to Drury school in Milton when classes resume in the fall. The board purchased the facility from the Association for \$1 in 1969 when the board was formed. The school had developed from efforts of the Association since its beginning in 1955 and the association would like to use it again.

The Association wants to set up a developmental program for severely handicapped a-

dults which would teach social, self-help, pre-vocational and allied skills. Such a program does not exist at present.

The board has disposed of a similar school in Oakville and education director Emmerson Lavender reminded board members that while there may be some difference between the two situations there are also similarities.

Business and finance directors Bruce Lindley said it would be about six weeks after the school closes before efforts would be made to get it off the board's hands. The Association could be informed then of what interest the board had in their offer.
