Acton's McKenzie-Smith Middle School will lose its vice-principal in June.

Carl Hymers, who served as vice-principal there since 1978 and spent three years before that as vice-principal at Georgetown's Centennial Middle School, was elevated to a principal's position by the Halton Board of Education Thursday night.

He will go to Linwood Public School in Oakville.

Also stepping up to a principal's post next year will be Win Procyshen. Mrs. Procyshen is a resource special education teacher at Nelson High School but spent part of 1978 as vice-principal of Stewarttown Senior School and was viceprincipal at Georgetown's George Kennedy Public School from 1975 to 1978.

She will take on her new role at Pauline Johnson Public School in Burlington in September.
