 Situated in the Old Bank, The Cellar has retained the old tellers counter as the bar and use the original vault for storage space. The walls were sandblasted to the pink brick and the rooms are further enhanced by a cozy fireplace.

CANADIAN IMPERIAL BANK OF COMMERCE

James Longley
 In December, 1875, an Agency of the Bank of Hamilton was opened in Georgetown and this was the first Bank in the County of Halton. The first office was situated on the south-west side of Main Street in the building opposite the Knox Presbyterian Church.
 In 1917 the Bank moved to a handsome three-storey stone building (erected in 1890) located on the corner of Main and Mill Streets, now the site of the new premises. In 1923, the Bank of Hamilton was taken over by the Canadian Bank of Commerce.
 On February 1st, 1943, the Georgetown Branch of the Bank of Montreal was closed and all the accounts were transferred to the Bank of Commerce.
 On June 1st, 1961, the Bank merged with the Imperial Bank to form the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce. In September, 1969, the Bank set up temporary quarters on Mill Street in the former home and office of the late Dr. R. T. Paul.
 In May of 1970, the stone building which was for so long the home of the Bank in Georgetown, and the adjoining dry goods store which the Bank purchased from Mr. G. L. Garner, were taken down to make room for the new modern office in which you stand today.
 The present manager, James Longley, has been here a year and lives on Durham Street.
