

Dawson cows second highest

 Outstanding D.H.I.A. Herd Murray Dawson, R.R. 8, Milton, had the second highest herd for milk production under the Dairy Herd Improvement Association program in Ontario for 1979. Murray had 30 records averaging 162 Breed Class Average for milk and 156 B.C.A. for butterfat. This is 8,152 kilograms or some 18,000 pounds of milk and 290 kg of fat with a 3.5 per cent test.

Three years ago Murray took over the farm from his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Harold Dawson. The cows receive silage and some hay along with a grain ration containing corn, mixed grain and a 34 per cent non-urea supplement.

There were 8 cows in the herd that produced over 9,000 kg of milk. They were as follows: Rosemarie, a good plus by Unique, with 9,737 kg of milk and B.C.A.'s of 194 and 230; Linda Rocket, a very good by Unique, with 9,700 kg of milk and B.C.A.'s of 209 and 197; Bell, a good plus by Unique, 10,289 milk and 209-190 B.C.A.; Delight, good plus by Unique, 9,985 milk and 198-184; Mark Leanne, good plus by Perseus Mark, 10,049 milk, 195-184; Grace Ana, good plus by Emperor, 9,830 milk, 190-185; a good by Starlite with 9,216 milk and 169-177; and a good plus by Milkman, 9,981 milk and 180-170.

Rail emergency could happen

Red Cross practice disaster

Just imagine that on a cold, snowy night in early March, a Canadian National train carrying pulpwood, propane, cars and trucks derailed near the Moore Park subdivision and a fire was burning out of control at the scene.

Kearsey said. In the morning session of the day-long workshop, the participants in the workshop learn how to carry out an evacuation, what the Red Cross can provide in the way of food, clothing and shelter, how

to transport people to evacuation centres, and how to set up communications systems, internally and externally. In the afternoon session, the participants divided up into groups and used the techniques learned in the morning to

map out a strategy for handling the mock disaster. Mr. Kearsey said the town and the police are working on their own emergency plans, and the Red Cross is working with them to fit the plans together.

What do you do?

That scenario was drawn up by the Georgetown branch of the Canadian Red Cross to instruct people in the techniques of responding to a disaster. The emergency services division of the Red Cross held a mini-workshop Saturday at the Oddfellows Hall to instruct people on what to do in a disaster.

Gord Kearsey, head of operations for the emergency services division, said the workshop is designed to instruct as many people as possible in disaster response techniques. The Red Cross hopes to have about 350 people in Georgetown trained in these techniques by this time next year. They hope to hold another workshop in October.

In the mock disaster drawn up by the Red Cross, a fire is burning out of control at the site of the train derailment, and it is necessary to evacuate about 700 to 1,000 people from the area. Because the evacuation is taking place at about 3 a.m., most of the evacuees will be in their nightclothes, Mr.
