Of course, Mexico City boasts many other attractions. The world's largest bullring is there, plus a mini-ring where brave tourists can have a try with a rented bull.

Acapulco has come a long way since the days when the Castle San Diego guarded the harbor against Sir Francis Drake and various privateers.

Unique thrills

Today, flaming torches adjacent to the castle walls add romantic flavor to evening concens, and ballet is performed in the Cultural Exhibition Center. The famous cliff divers thrill millions of visitors every year.

Para sailing and glass-bottom boat rides can provide refreshing breaks for sun-bathers whose home-away-from-home may be as luxurious as the Acapulco Princess, a modern archiicctural wonder, and the largest of more than two-dozen hotels

in Acapulco.

One of the most unique of these "hotels" is Las Brisasin the hills overlooking Acapulco Bay. It is made up of 300 casitas (individual cottages) with in-room bars and refrigerators, and 250 individual swimming pools.




