Mexico's mixture of cultures attracts Americans

You can bargain for hand-made silver cups in shops that line cobblestone streets. Ride the wind currents on a parachute launched from water skis. And visit pyramids, volcanoes, cathedrals and bullfights.

Too much for one vacation? Not for visitors to Mexico, a land of contrasts between modern western civilization and great civilizations of the past.

Mexico's contrasts are apparent almost everywhere. While the coastal resorts draw sun worshippers, culture buffs admire such inland ruins as the pyramids of the Sun and the Moon at Teotihuacan, 30 miles

north of Mexico City, just one of 10,000 known archaeological sites throughout Mexico.

At Chichen Itza, the most famous Mayan ruins in the Yucatan, a 500-foot Ball Court was once used by athletes for Pok-Ta-Pok, a combination of soccer, lacrosse and basketball. Stakes were high; losers were beheaded!

Many of the best artifacts can be seen in and about Mexico City, and especially at the National Museum of Anthropology, completed in 1964.

pultepec Castle, where Emperor Maximilian once lived. It is now the Museum of Natural History.

At Zocalo, the main square, a Spanish cathedral is built on Aztec foundations, while at Plaza of the Three Cultures, an Aztec ruin, Spanish church and ultra-modern government building coexist.

When the city's subway was dug in the '60s, Aztec artifacts were excavated and later placed

on public display.

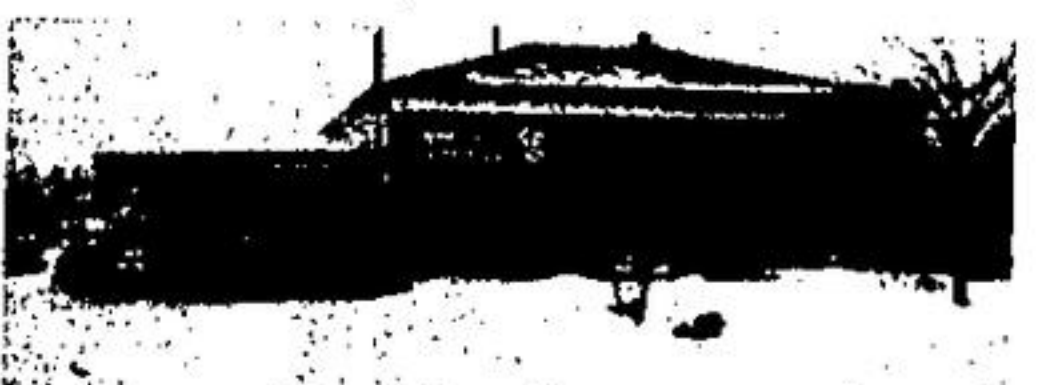
