

Women's soccer team organized for league

At a meeting in Cedarvale, Wednesday night, 35 people gathered to discuss women's soccer. As a result of that meeting the Georgetown Women's Soccer Club, for women 18 years and over came into being. The aim of the club is to promote recreational soccer at this time with the possibility of competitive soccer some time in the future.

Des Rafferty gave assurance that the Georgetown Youth Soccer Club would make provision for fields this year, once a schedule is prepared.

It is intended that the women's soccer teams from Pineview, Milton, Bolton and Georgetown will participate in a Rural League similar to that already in existence for girls. Twentyfive women have already registered to play, which is enough for two teams. There is room for another 25 women so that we can field more teams. The registration is \$15.00 for a player-member, and for members only (non-players) \$2.00.

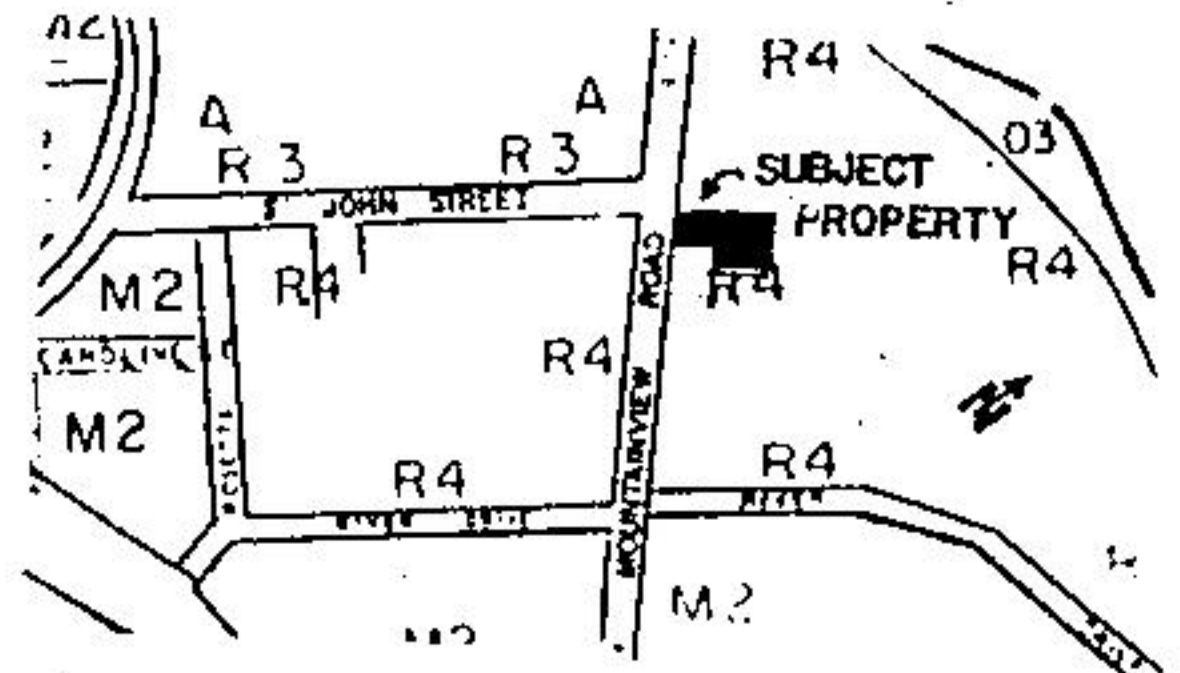
