GLT to hold a phone-a-thon for proposed cultural centre

The Georgetown Little Theatre will be holding a phone-a-thon tonight (Wednesday) to help sell more plaques for seats in the proposed library-cultural centre complex.

The group has already sent out letters to members, patrons and friends of little theatre, seeking support for its drive to raise \$30,000 towards the cost of the proposed cultural centre by selling plaques which will be attached to the rear of seats in the theatre.

The phonecalls tonight are designed as a follow-up to letters. "Old-guard" members of the GLT, people who have been with the group for several years, and who are well-known in the community, will be

placing the calls, while other members of the group will be picking up pledges from people's homes. GLT publicity chairman Mary Rae Main said.

The phone-a-thon will be taking place from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. in the office of the Independent newspaper on Main Street South. GLT hopes to have the model of the proposed complex in the office, and is encouraging people to walk in and make a pledge towards a plaque, rather than waiting for a phone call.

The cost of purchasing a plaque is a minimum donation of \$110, or \$120 if the pledge is paid by a series of postdated cheques. The cost of the plaques will be used to cover the GLT pledge of \$30,000.

Mrs. Main said the pledges have been coming in slowly but steadily since the first letters

went out. Many of the pledges are for more than the minimum \$110, she said.

TOPS TO HOLD WALK-A-THON

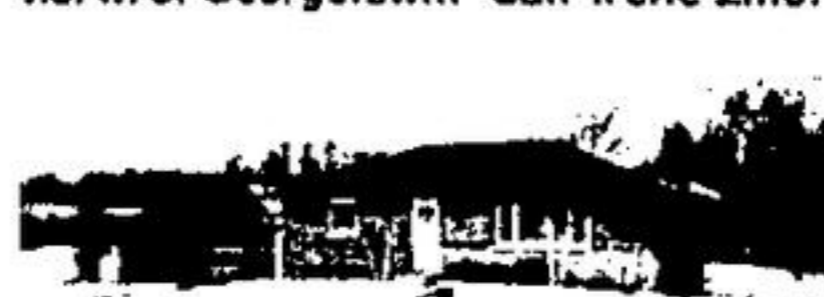
