The early store was located next to Silver's present store, and such a building is non-existent today. Henry moved his enterprise to his well-known landmark, where today he serves customers from all over the country, who have become acquainted with his line of good quality clothes very well.

Henry Helfant learned his trade in Belgium where he was born. He emigrated to Canada in 1946 after the end of the Second World War in which he served in the Second Scotch Battalion.

Changes in the business over the years have included the building of quality lines of clothing of which Henry is proud. The public demand looking for a prestigious line of clothes and Henry's own pride as a tailor, makes this a clothing store of distinction.

Henry does a lot of commissioned tailoring for uniformed public services. Tenders come in and he quotes in a competitive manner and enjoys good business from this type of trade. "Some jockeys buy their suits from me and many key personalities," he said.

Operating one of the oldest established businesses in Georgetown, perhaps "the oldest", says Henry, he is known as "The Godfather" of Main Street.
