two-day period. "It will be a smaller fest this year, but I think the quality will be better than last year's," Mrs. Day said. "For this reason, only those belonging to the Arts Council will be showing their work this year."

THREE JUDGES There will also be three

out-of-town judges who will evaluate all paintings, sculptures, crafts and other entries. Entries will go into either the professional class or amateur class for judging.

"There will also be a haywagon this year which will take people between Pioneer Day festivities on Main Street and Summerfest activities here in Cedarvale," Mrs. Day said. "Unfortunately, the wagon can't be drawn by a horse. Apparently, they had a problem once when a horsedrawn float ran away with a local beauty queen, so it will have to be a tractor-drawn

Coun. John McDonald will also be conducting an historical walk between the downtown area and Cedarvale. Mrs. Day also announced

that a series of three concerts, called Musical Tri-Light, will begin October 29. The first concert will feature a folk

group called Maple Sugar singing a variety of French and English folk songs and dances that have been collected from all over Canada. The concert will take place at Georgetown District High

The second concert will take place February 1, 1981, and will feature the Tapestry Singers. The group performs skits and music from theatrical productions dating from 1920 to the present time. This concert will be at the Acton High School.




