Parks plan's advice to sell local parkette 'astonishing'--Mary Street residents say

EDITOR'S NOTE: Following are copies of letters to town council submitted to The Herald for publication.

Dear Sir:

We have studied the Master Plan for Parks and Recreation Facilities prepared by Balmer, Crapo and Associates, in which it is recommended that

the Mary Street Park should be sold for three residential building lots because "the property is too small."




