

Sacre-Coeur association plans meeting

Georgetown's Ecole Sacre-Coeur, a French language separate school established in 1960, has become a very dynamic team-spirited facet of our community. Not only does the school provide kindergarten-to-grade 8 instruction in French on all subjects (including religious instructions), but English language arts is also taught starting in grade 3, such that by grade 8 the students have been well prepared to move directly on to any high school of their choice in Ontario with no difficulty at all.

This Catholic school is for children whose mother tongue is French or who have one French-speaking parent; school taxes must be directed to the separate school system. It operates separately with its own budget, principal and teaching staff, while sharing facilities (at 222 Maple Avenue East in Georgetown - bus transportation as far as Milton) with an English-speaking elementary school, Holy Cross. The two schools participate jointly in some activities, as does Sacre-Coeur with other English-speaking schools as part of its English program, especially in those activities organized in English by the school board.

Many of the extra-curricular activities-projects are nevertheless organized around a francophone atmosphere, touching on various aspects of French-Canadian culture and national pride. To cite only a few examples, specific activities include: Projct Parlois, Francals, Carnaval D'hiver, Oral Communications Festival

grades 5-8 competition with other schools), Foire Scientifique (public and Cable-TV demos of science projects), francophone concerts-folklore-theatre arts, exchange trips with other francophone schools in Southern Ontario, as well as workshops on drama, cooking, visual arts and photography; on the sports side, there are several intra- and inter-mural activities such as cross-country competitions, track and field, volleyball, skating and swimming.

Most impressive is the dedication of the school's principal, Mrs. Paulette Normand, as well as the team spirit of her staff in making all this happen. This team spirit extends itself well into the francophone community at Halton Hills. Parent volunteers regularly assist the teachers on class trips, at the Library, for piano playing, and, of very special interest, on the school's child-centered remedial program for grades 1-6. Sacre-Coeur has its own very active parent-teacher association (APT), which not only supports many of the school activities but also ensures that sufficient funds are raised to make available the many extras at this unique school.

All parents interested in learning more about Sacre-Coeur's very diversified program are invited to attend the annual general meeting of the APT to be held at Sacre-Coeur school Wednesday May 28, 8 p.m.; or to simply call the principal, Mrs. Normand, at 877-5056 for more detailed information.

Need permits for work done

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority (CVCA) will be applying for retroactive permits from the Niagara Escarpment Commission for development work done at Terra Cotta Conservation Area.

The CVCA has been doing what general manager Glenn Schnarr termed "routine development work", which included the temporary placement of outhouses, wells, trail bridges, replacement of fences, culvert extensions,

road widenings, and building of dock ramps at Terra Cotta. However, the Niagara Escarpment Commission has said that because the commission's control zone includes Terra Cotta and the Orangeville Reservoir, the CVCA should apply for retroactive permits to 1975 to cover the work that has been done. Mr. Schnarr said Thursday night the CVCA will make a presentation to the hearing officers at hearings on the proposed plan for the escarpment on the problem.

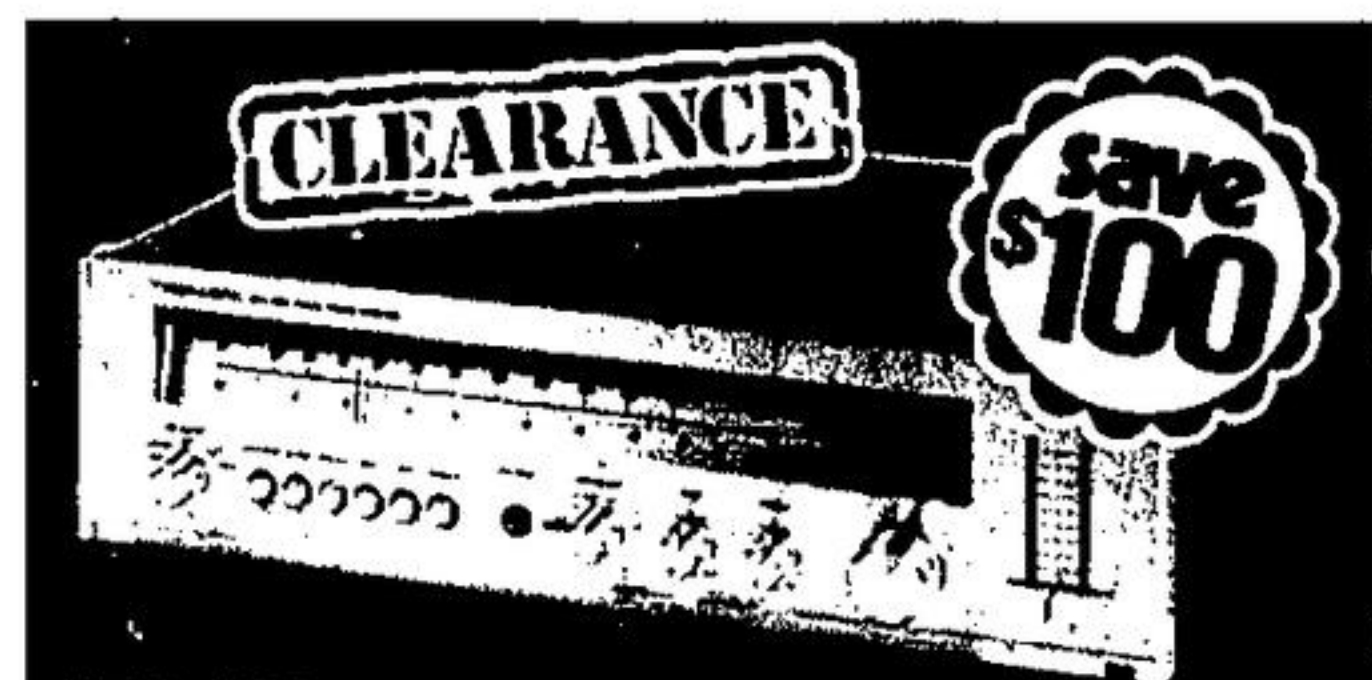
