

# Red Cross wars rage world apart

The Canadian Red Cross continues to wage daily battles against two modern crises a world apart, but only through additional funds and other contributions can the war be effectively carried on.

In the mountainous Kurram district of Pakistan, the Red Cross is assisting local officials in relief work among some 86,000 Afghan refugees, while around the world in El Salvador, the League of Red Cross Societies is appealing for aid in helping the victims of

political conflict. "These refugees from Afghanistan, including the 33,000 children among them, have suffered so much," a Pakistani government official remarked. "So far they have only received the little help the

government can give them and relief supplies from one foreign country. They have received no other help at all." On the day he spoke, the first small consignment of Pakistani Red Crescent quilts and medical supplies had arrived.

They had been driven across several mountain ranges during the eight hours' journey from Peshawar. "We need all the help you can send," the officer, Haji Taj Mohammad Khan told a delegate from the Red Cross League.

"In this area temperatures fall to zero on the mountains at night, and the refugees are on the mountains. Some of them brought only two or three blankets. We have only been able to supply seven or eight thousand blankets and 1,800 tents for these 80,000 refugees."

He added that although 86,000 refugees were registered, there could be "about 20,000 unregistered refugees" living somewhere in the mountains receiving no help whatsoever. The internal situation in El Salvador is worsening rapidly. During the most recent events in the capital, more than 500 people were killed and 300 wounded. Daily, there are

isolated confrontations which increase the number of killed, wounded and missing. This situation has generated a large-scale economic problem which prevents the Salvadoran Red Cross Society from carrying out a fund-raising campaign. The Salvadoran Red Cross has been on the job from the outset. Currently, it is continuing the ambulance service and the upkeep of emergency medical and surgical clinics. These vital services must be maintained. The operational cost of both services is estimated at \$210,000 (U.S.) from March to December, 1980.
