Seaside Fun Fest in B.C.

Does your bathtub get three kilometres to the litre? Or your backyard biffy eight knots with four men paddling?

During British Columbia's Fun Fest '80 celebrations they do - and more. It's all part of a summer-long series of festivals down the coast and rivers of Canada's westernmost province.

New Westminster's Hyack (Chinook for hurry up) Festival leads off with a big bang - 21 to be more precise. The Ancient and Honourable Hyack Anvil Battery, dressed in their distinctive black and red uniforms, officially open the traditional Victoria Day celebrations on May 24 - but not quite as you would expect.

Queen Victoria's christening, 109 years ago, of New Westminster, then B.C.'s capital, was the start of the annual celebration. It was to be fittingly launched with a 21 gun salute. Embarrassingly enough, the army's gun was not available so the mayor, a blacksmith, donated two anvils to local firemen. After some singed eyebrows and minor bruises they got just the right amount of gunpowder and a long enough detonating rod for the perfect anvil chorus.

The salute is the send-off for a week of car rallies, parades, lacrosse, soccer and other sporting events, a grueling canoe marathon down the Fraser River, the longest one-day canoeing race in North America, parades and dances and the seldom-seen Maypole dance.

The famous (and delicious) Pacific salmon is the star of Campbell River's summer festival on Vancouver Island from June 27 to July 1. Fishing derbies, a watermelon eating contest, raft races and the Cod Jiggers atomp fill the last week of June. The wind-up weekend highlights a Canada Day fireworks display, raft races and for the little ones, trike races (bring your own) and a Huck Finn derby for the six to 16 year crowd.

Now it's up the Fraser River to Quesnel for Billy Barker Days, July 17 to 20. This is gold country, so grab a pan, roll up your sleeves and try your luck. There's even a World Gold Pan Throwing Championship - obviously inspired by some disgruntled and frustrated soundough.

Rockhounds and the curl-

ous should take in the Rock and Gem show where both semi-precious stones and rough rocks are on display. For sports fans the rodeo, baseball tournaments, motorbike and stock car competitions are a must - and for everyone there's the Annual Biffy Raft Race.

Raft, oars (or paddles) and all equipment are home built. No motors or hollow logs allowed and one crew member must occupy the biffy for the entire 16 km course.

Vancouver's Sea Festival, the granddaddy event, from July 12 to 22, features wheelchair competitions, hot air balloon rides, salmon barbecues, sand castle building contests and an endless list of things to do and see. On English Bay, representatives of the Haida, Nootka, Kwakwaka'wakw and Salish coastal Indians race canoes evolved from the war canoes of their ancestors. The modern day craft vary but the longest is the 11-man (or woman) war canoe, about 16 m.

Piloting craft of somewhat less classic lines are the participants in the annual World Championship Bath-tub Race from Nanaimo to Kitilano Beach. The tubs, gainly and un-, and more than a few shipping a good

deal of the Georgia Straits, provide a hilarious finale to the Festival.

Planning is well underway for the annual World Championship Logger Sports at the Squamish Days festival in early August and All Sooke Day (July 19). Come and watch the chokermen burling, double bucking, under- and overhand chopping, double bladed axe throwing and some of the most extraordinary axe work seen anywhere in the world.
