Georgetown resident Albert Phillip Young died at home June 16 at the age of 68. Mr. Young was born in Belleville, the son of Albert and Hannah (nee Cook). He lived in Belleville until 1930. He started work with Canadian

National Railways (CNR) as an office boy in 1928, and was transferred during his career to Brighton, Napanee, Mimico, Belleville, Oshawa and Toronto. He retired in 1976 and settled in Georgetown. At the time of

his retirement, Mr. Young was supervisor of signals-special duties for CNR. He was married October 24, 1935 to the former Catherine Fraser. Mr. Young was an avid bridge player and won the

I.O.D.E. marathon bridge tournament for the last three years. His other interests included gardening, especially roses, bowling and golf. He was also a volunteer driver for the Canadian Cancer Society.

THREE-BEDROOM BUNGALOW HAS FULL BASEMENT

Here's a charming compact three bedroom bungalow which is perfectly suited to the narrow-to-medium frontage residential building lot, but which contains in excess of 1,200 square feet of well thought-out finished floor area. A full basement provides abundant space for the future development of additional bedrooms or recreational facilities, enabling a dramatic increase in useable living area at a later date. The smartly styled exterior, finished in vertical and horizontal channel siding, with brick veneer accents and chimney, and heavy shake roof, presents a pleasingly low-profile facade which would complement any urban residential development.

The weather-protected entry leads into a compact sunken reception foyer, from which traffic moves up two risers, past the outdoor storage area, and naturally to the left into the long rectangular living-dining room combination. The living room features a raised-hearth masonry fireplace, for convivial "at home", and wide, front-facing windows for view and natural light. The rear-facing dining area separates from the kitchen-nook via spacing-saving pocket door for privacy when entertaining formally.

The well-planned L-configuration kitchen has ample cupboard storage capacity, generous countertop work surface and a step-saving work triangle. The breakfast nook invites the custom installation of banquette-style furnishings, yet provides adequate space for a full dining suite. The kitchen-dinette provides access to the full basement via stairwell connecting to the rear entry. It may also be

totally isolated via pocket doors for privacy and hygiene. All three bedrooms are positioned around the central bathroom and linen storage facility, and well away from the main entertaining area for freedom from disturbance. Each has good exposure for view and natural light, and each has ample closet storage. The large master bedroom has a full walk-in closet and a three-piece ensuite bath with shower.

This eye-appealing and practical compact design affords abundant space and convenient layout for the medium-size family.
