Excitement in Scandinavia

Only far-northerners, who know how cold and dark winter really can be, can lavish their fullest appreciation on spring.

Scandinavians know, and they accord the vernal equinox a rousing welcome that sends Old Man Winter running for cover.

The Danes, Finns, Norwegians and Swedes demonstrate their native spirit with exceptional flair when spring flowers show their faces and brilliant sun illuminates the surfaces of lakes and fjords.

As long nights turn into stretched-out days, fresh greenery brightens the cityscapes of Copenhagen, Helsinki, Oslo and Stockholm.

Outdoor types take picnic baskets out of storage, and orchestras begin to tune up for the outdoor concert season.

If spring comes, Midsummer's Eve can't be far behind, and music buffs tune up for the big event at jazz clubs, which flourish in all Scandinavian capitals.

For a modest admission fee and the price of a couple of drinks (stay away from imported brands, however—the prices alone can set you reeling), an evening of top-quality music can be yours.

Whether Dixieland, bebop or contemporary jazz are to your taste, an imposing array of clubs serves up a musical feast.

At Oslo's Club Seven, local jazz artists keep rafters ringing and customers singing and, on any evening, an itinerant international may drop by and sit in on a few sessions.

In Stockholm, Bofaget is the name to remember for the hottest music in town.

Stampen, another local favorite, presents top jazz musicians from across the world.

With the arrival of spring, jazz festivals sprout like wildflowers, turning Scandinavia into a four-country panorama of sound.

Among the best: The Porei Festival in Finland, The Kronsburg Jazz Festival in Norway, The Malmö Festival in Sweden and the Kristianstad Festival in Norway.

Music having worked its

charms and savage brows properly soothed, you'll be in a suitable mood to explore Scandinavia's other delights.

Somewhere, even in such a contemporary capital as Stockholm, you'll manage to come upon some hidden-away cobbled lanes and medieval houses. Helsinki, which nestles amid pine forests, presents a very

20th century aspect, but you can dine on fresh salmon and reindeer steak—Finnish staples for centuries. Sauna, another staple of Finnish life, merits a try also.

In that most seafaring of all Scandinavian capitals known as Oslo, you can explore Viking ships, study the original Kon-Tiki and take a ride on a hydrofoil.
