

Jack E. Harrison loved sports activities

John E. (Jack) Harrison died in Georgetown Hospital July 8. He was 77.

A long-time resident at 45 Ontario Street, Mr. Harrison was born and raised in England, the son of John William and Esther Harrison. He was married to Theresa Barber July 20, 1929, in St. George's Anglican Church in Georgetown and worked for Donnar Paper, Smith and Stone and finally, Abitibi Pulp and Paper.

Mr. Harrison was well-known in town for his affiliation with the Georgetown Raiders hockey club and the Lorne Scots Brass Band. For years he was a trainer with the Raiders and with the Georgetown Lacrosse Club.

He was also an avid cribbage and dart player and enjoyed fishing.

Mr. Harrison is survived by his mother, Esther, and his widow, Theresa, as well as by their two children, Mrs. Shirley Fendley of R.R.1 Georgetown and Mrs. J. Coitigan of Waterloo.

Mr. Harrison is interred at Greenwood Cemetery, Georgetown.

Experience '80 of the Credit Valley Conservation Authority, now in its eighth week, is approximately half over. Several creeks, from Orangeville to Port Credit have been cleaned, thousands of small trees and shrubs have been planted along river banks, and several parks have had the grass cut and have been cleaned of debris.

The revamping of the Orton Community Park near Erin will be the next major project.

The jobs are not all tedious for the students, however, and sometimes the jobs can get glamorous. Several newspapers have been reporting on their progress. The students have become quite accustomed to posing for photographers and talking to reporters.

Local residents appreciate the students, as two wallets have been recovered from one creek and two small children have received first aid when they were hurt near an Experience '80 job site.

The program may be cancelled next year though due to a reallocation of government spending. It is government sponsored and has been running for ten years. In 1971, it began as SWEEP - Students Working (for) Environmental Enhancement Program. Conservation Authorities throughout Ontario appreciate the Experience program as the students help take some of the work load off their shoulders.

Credit Valley has twenty-seven people in their Experience program this year. Every morning they meet at the Authority's main office in Meadowdale, and depart for their job sites in trucks leased by the ministry of natural resources.
