Halton Hills' market value assessment study is slowly gathering steam, but it may be two or three months before it produces any conclusive findings, Ward 1 Coun. Rosa Knechtel told The Herald this

The "in-house" study was launched a month and a half ago following a bitter June 16 public meeting at which irate Actonians living in the Bovis Street subdivision complained that the town's property assessment system is forcing them to pay unfairly high

Residents in newer areas of Acton may pay as much as 48 per cent more in taxes on their properties than neighbors living in older homes.

On June 23, Mayor Pete Pomeroy appointed councillors Knechtel, Russ Miller. Harry Levy and Walter Blehn to conduct the study, along with four Halton Hills citizensof which only two-Lorne Youngblut of Acton and Laurie Duggan of Georgetown have been named so far.

TOWN READY The committee will determine whether or not the town is ready for Section 86 of the Provincial Assessment Act. Ifthe section is adopted by the town, property would be assessed on its market value causing assessments on newer property to fall, while rising on older homes, hopefully approaching a reasonable

Coun. Knechtel said Sunday that the committee will "try and document the effects of (market value) assessment in Halton Hills" by reviewing unequalized assessment problems dealt with in other municipalities such as Milton and Hamilton.

But, Coun. Knechtel said, "we have the additional problem in Halton Hills because not all the areas are on the same assessment".

Other complications include the possibility that some homes have been wrongly assessed in the past and the assessment would change if Section 88 is applied.

A recent tax break in which the province pays half the property taxes of senior citizens who own their own home may not prove to be much of a break after all under equalized assessment. Seniors living in older homes may see their property assessment increase under Section 86, along with their taxes.

Coun. Knechtel said that the study has been hindered during the summer because possible sources have been away on vacation. **OUTSIDE ANSWERS**


We have to go outside for a lot of our answers," he said, "so the study could take longer than you'd like it to." But, Coun. Knechtel, said he does not want to hastily conduct the study. "There's too much at stake." Meanwhile, Coun. Knechtel

has applied to council for a \$500 committee allowance to pay for printing costs and mileage for visiting experts helping with the assessment Coun. Harry Levy said that "up to \$500" may be found in

the budget for the committee. The matter will be discussed by council later this month.
