Town's legal firm loses 9-year partner

"I'm sure that on behalf of council, I wish you every success in your new position." And with that, Mayor Pete Pomeroy joined his council to bid farewell to lawyer Ray Steele following his final municipal presentation last Tuesday evening.

Mr. Steele had been a partner with the town's legal firm, Helson, McMillan, Kogon and Associates for almost nine years. At the first of this month, he joined the legal firm of Elliott, Warne and Carter of Toronto.

"I look forward to the change and the challenge," Mr. Steele said from his new office in the Simpson's Tower on the corner of Bay and Queen.

"I enjoyed my work for the municipality and my association with the people of Georgetown," he said. "I have nothing but good memories." Mr. Steele joined the Helson

law firm in March, 1971, and was named a full partner by September of that year.

Mr. Steele graduated from the University of Manitoba in 1965 and was called to the bar following his graduation from Osgoode Hall in 1968.

Prior to joining the Helson law firm, he worked as a legal clerk for George Gayle, former chief justice of Ontario. Although Fred Helson would not say who will take over the vacancy left by Mr. Steele's departure, 27-year old Tom

Anderson joined the firm Monday.

Mr. Anderson, who received his bachelor of arts degree in history and political science from the University of Toronto, graduated from the University of Ottawa with a law degree two years ago. He was called to the bar in March of this year.

Mr. Anderson said that he and his wife Karen will be "moving out of Toronto soon", possibly to settle in the Georgetown area.

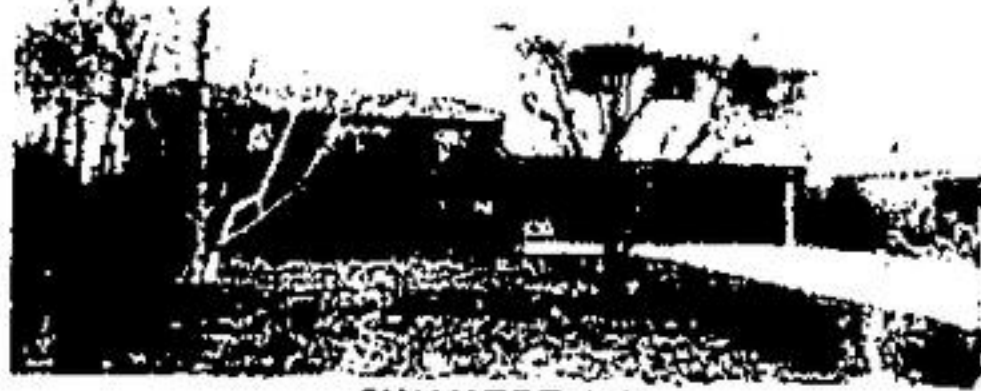

their selection of leisure activities.

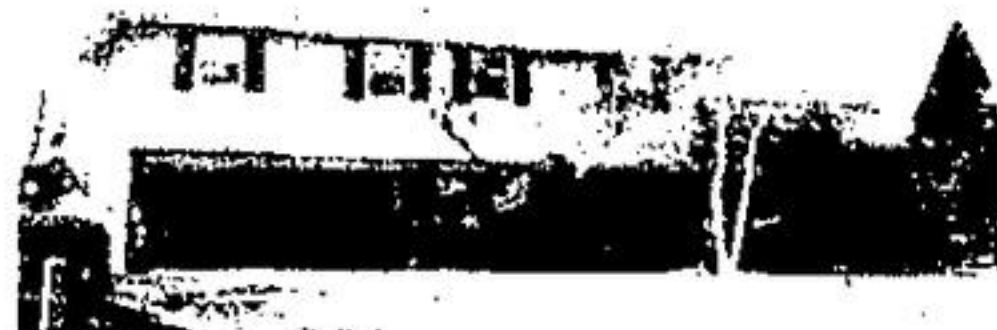
• In the 18-22 year old group, the companion is more important than the activity.
