

The Cubs have 17 boys and three leaders, with Elaine Hannah as Cubmaster at 877-7492. They had three boys - Gary Foster, Billy Shoelridge and Wally Clark - attend the Sixer Training Day for all sixers in the District held in the Limehouse Hall.

The Scouts have four leaders with Dick Rock as Scoutmaster at 877-8776. So far they have 11 boys registered and are looking forward to organizing a log jousting event at the Scouting Exhibit at the Georgetown Fall Fair.

We now have a Venturer Company being formed under the leadership of Dick Rock and have six boys registered in the Company. For the moment their biggest task is getting organized and we wish them well.

The Group Committee had a meeting a couple of weeks ago with a very poor turn-out but went ahead and made some plans anyway. As a result, this past Saturday they held a carwash with coffee and muffins on the side. It took place at Murt Allison's on Highway 7. The parents were in charge but some of the Cubs and Scouts came along to help where they could. While the carwash was being held other parents helped with the monthly paper drive which took quite awhile this month because papers had not been collected all summer.

Limehouse Hall was the scene last Saturday for the training of all Cub Sixers and Seconds. Each Pack divides its boys into groups of six boys. At the head of each six is a boy who is called a Sixer. He has an assistant in the six who is called a second (for second-in-command). Each year in the District a day is set aside to train these boys for their role and responsibility in the Pack.

Some of the sessions they have included the proper way to do the Grand Howl (their opening ceremony); the proper way to wear their uniforms and badges; how to communicate; how to lead games; leadership skills and their actual job within the Pack.

This year there were 70 boys who attended this event and there were 70 leaders who attended and took part in training these boys.
