A series of university appearances and shows with the Abbey Players followed; his latter involvement has featured portrayals of key characters in "The Gondoliers", "HMS Pinafore" and "Yeoman of the Guard".

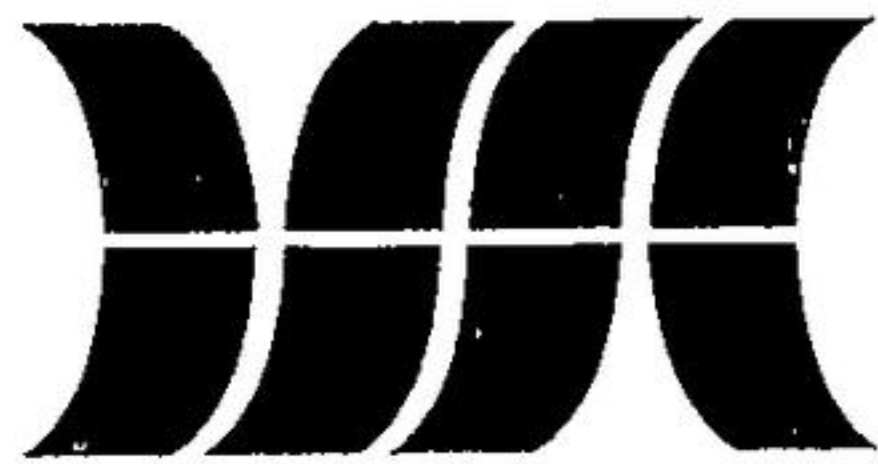
Mr. Smedley has honed his

harmonic skills singing duets with mezzo Eleanor James of the Canadian Opera Company. Mrs. Welton trained at England's Winchester School of Art and Music and the London Opera Centre before assuming numerous key roles

in many operas. Since immigrating, she has been a founding member of the Brampton Oratorio Society and has performed several times with the Abbey Players. This year, she was nominated as Best Actress in the annual

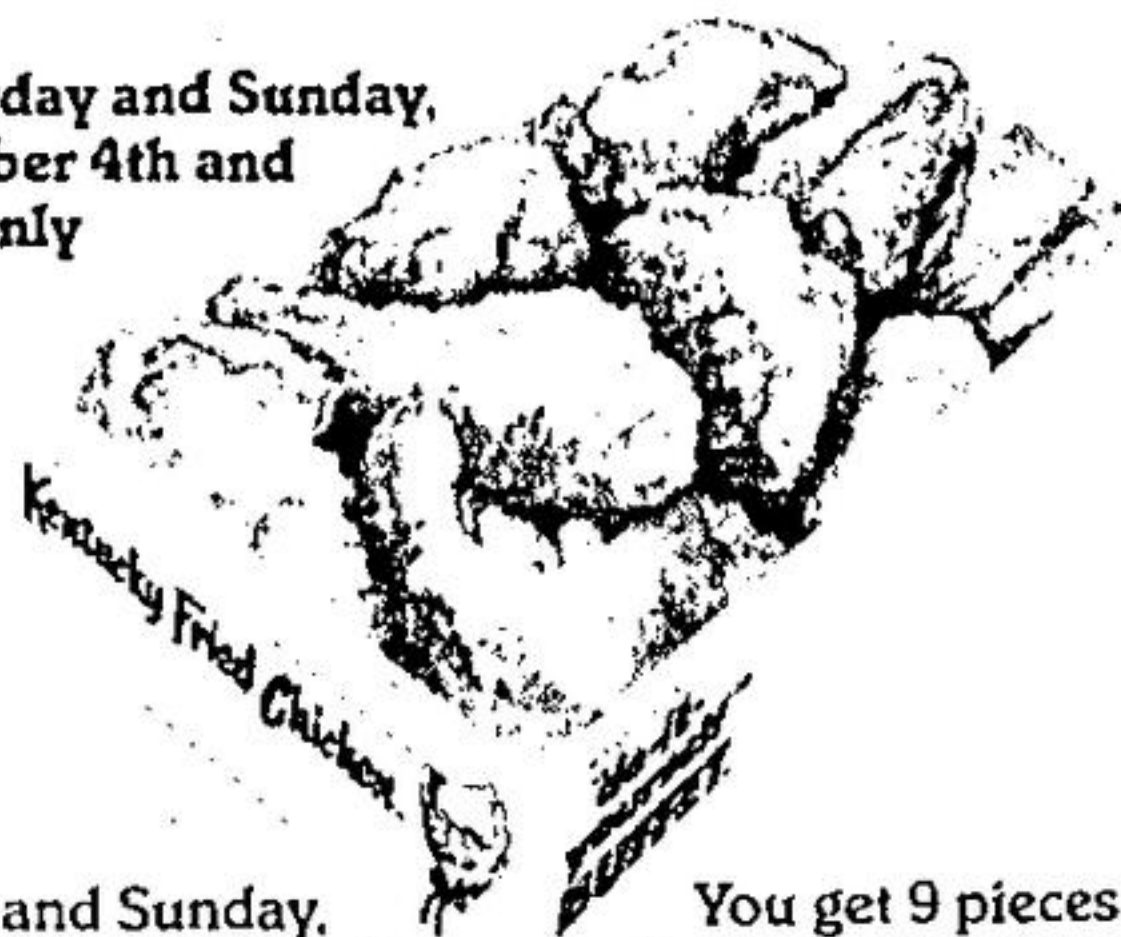
